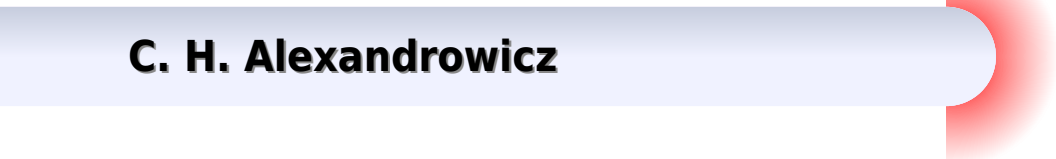

historical crime and the divisive politics of genocide it produced The book throws light not only on our understanding of Armenian Turkish relations but also of how mass atrocities and historical tragedies shape contemporary politics
