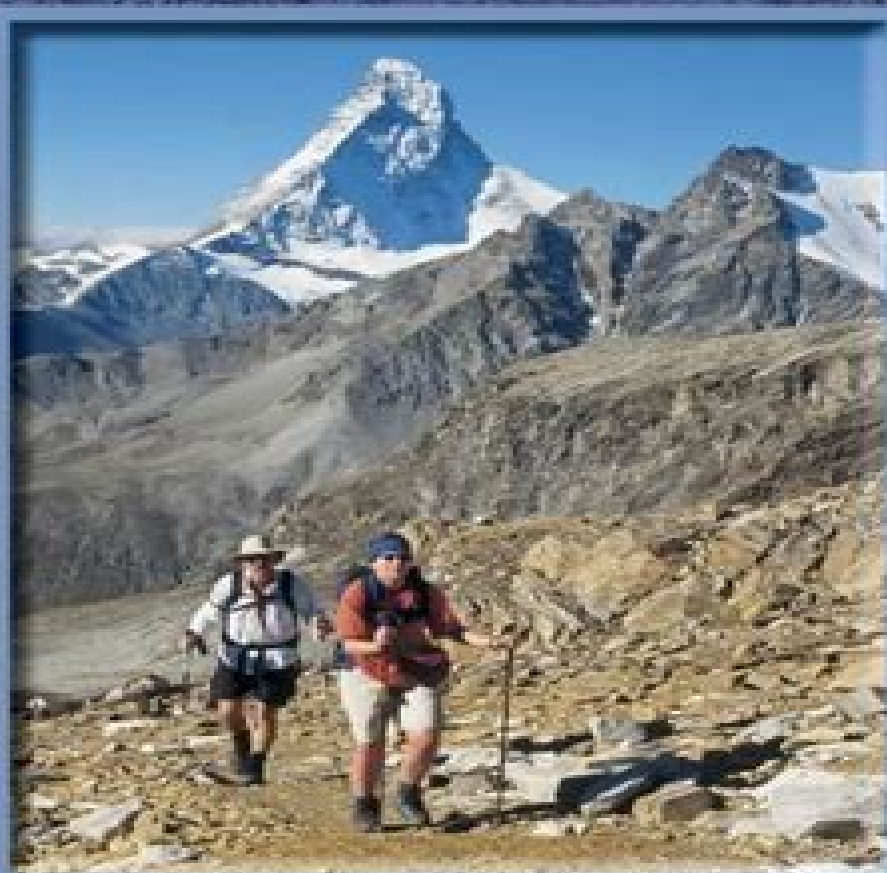

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Tour of the Matterhorn Hilary Sharp, 2006 A guide to the 145km Tour of the Matterhorn described anti clockwise from Zermatt and visits 6 valleys via Zinal Arolla and Breuil offering spectacular views of 25 peaks of over 4000m The route also links up with the Chamonix to Zermatt walkers Haute Route and the Tour of Monte Rosa Includes two glacier crossings and takes 8 to 10 days

Trekking the Robert Louis Stevenson Trail Nike Werstroh, Jacint Mig, 2021-02-15 Robert Louis Stevenson s Travels with a donkey in the C vennes is a classic of travel literature The GR70 long distance trail is based on the author s route allowing walkers to follow in the footsteps of Stevenson and his four legged companion Modestine through the beautiful C vennes region on the edge of France s Massif Central The route is ideal for both first time trekkers and more experienced hikers covering around 272km of gently undulating countryside from Le Puy en Velay to Al s It can be completed in under a fortnight The trail is presented in 12 stages of 16 to 30km each with clear route description and mapping an elevation profile notes on local points of interest and a brief account of Robert Louis Stevenson s experiences on that section of the route There is useful advice for planning your trip including when to go what to take and how to get there and accommodation listings Following drove roads bridleways and footpaths the GR70 showcases the landscapes of the C vennes wildflower meadows rolling hills chestnut woods limestone gorges and meandering rivers Characterful villages provide accommodation and other services and offer an opportunity to sample the delicious local produce There are also glimpses into the region s fascinating history from pre historic burial sites to locations associated with the eighteenth century Protestant Camisards who resisted religious persecution While many things have undoubtedly changed since Stevenson s visit the area retains its authentic rural charm and you will soon discover just why Stevenson found it so appealing

Trekking Chamonix to Zermatt Kev Reynolds, 2024-03-19 A guidebook to the Walker s Haute Route a classic trek between Chamonix in France and Zermatt in Switzerland Covering 215km 134 miles this long distance trek linking Mont Blanc and the Matterhorn takes around 2 weeks and is suitable for trekkers with Alpine experience The route is described west to east in 14 stages each between 9 and 20km

are covered in this inspiring large format guidebook 30 routes are described ranging from 1 4 days with most suitable for a long weekend The routes are divided between the Western Highlands and Inner Hebrides the Central and Eastern Highlands the Northwest Highlands the Far North and the Outer Hebrides They are suitable for those with the experience and self reliance to navigate proficiently and stay safe in an environment which can easily become inhospitable Although some routes visit bothies most call for at least one night s wild camping Each walk includes overview data route description and 1 100 000 mapping and they are illustrated with stunning photos An introduction offers background information about the Highlands rich geology plants and wildlife and the historical and cultural context of Scotland s wilderness There is also practical information on preparing for an incursion and advice for those looking to expand their experience of wild country backpacking The Highlands and Islands of Scotland are home to the most ruggedly beautiful expansive and challenging backpacking country in the British Isles This is a land for those who love open spaces vast horizons and the domination of nature
