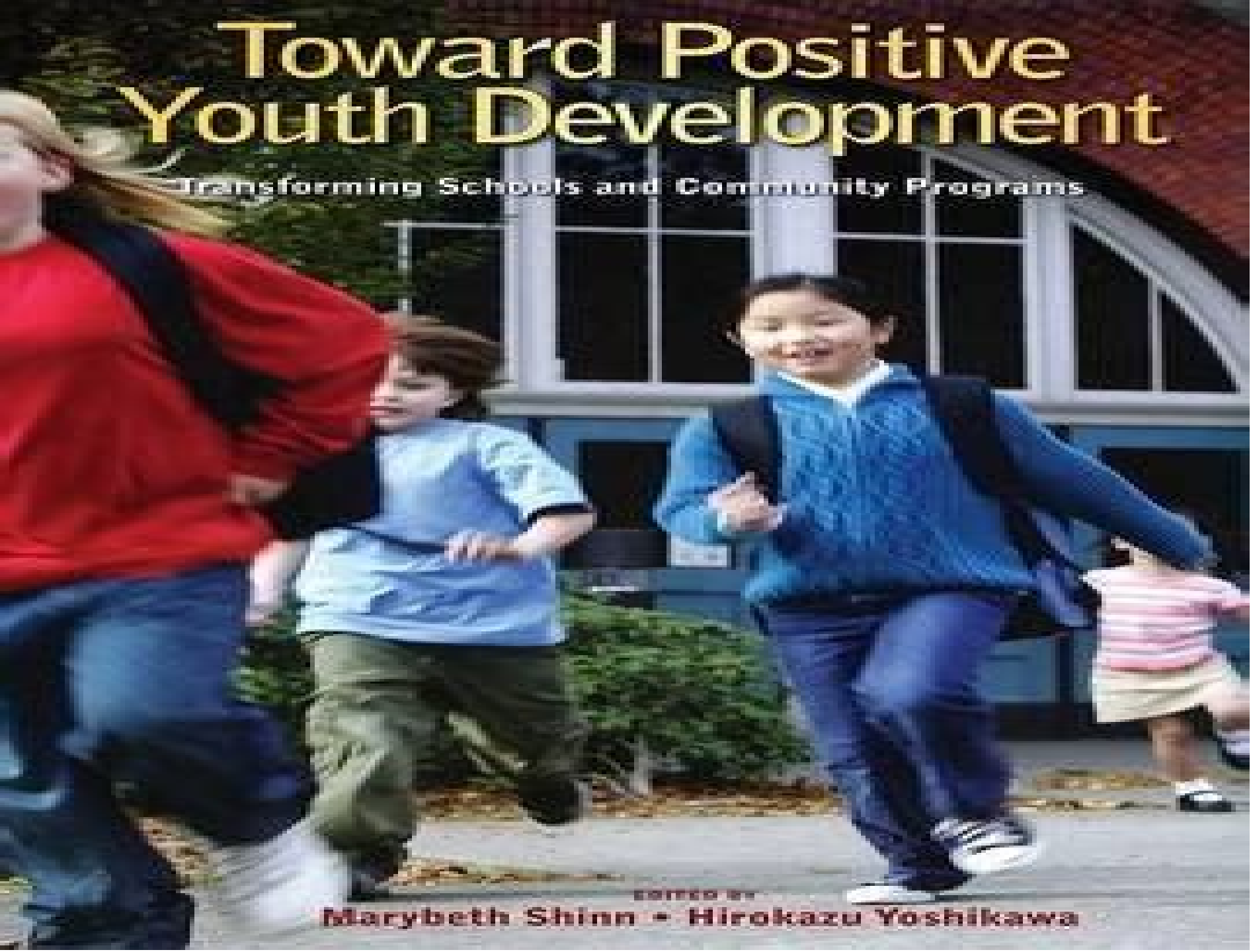

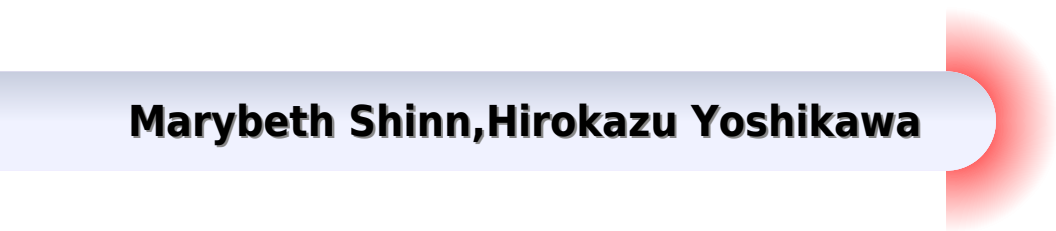

While participating in the famed Children's Crusade, he spent five terrifying nights in jail during which Freeman became a leader for the younger kids as he learned about the risk and sacrifice that it would take to fight for justice. Hrabowski went on to fuse his passion for education and for equality as he made his life's work inspiring high academic achievement among students of all races in science and engineering. It also brought him from Birmingham to Baltimore where he has been president of the University of Maryland Baltimore County for more than two decades. While at UMBC, he co-founded the Meyerhoff Scholars Program which has been one of the most successful programs for educating African Americans who go on to earn doctorates in the STEM disciplines.
