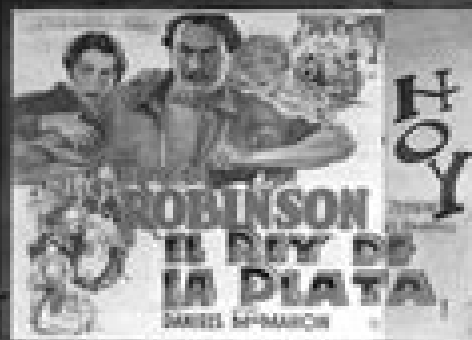

Walker Evans John T. Hill, Heinz Liesbrock, 2015-11-25 This resplendent volume is the most comprehensive study of Walker Evans's work ever published containing masterful images accompanied by authoritative commentary from leading photography historians. The name Walker Evans conjures images of the American everyman. Whether it's his iconic contributions to James Agee's depression-era classic book *Let Us Now Praise Famous Men*, his architectural explorations of antebellum plantations or his subway series taken with a camera hidden in his coat, Evans's accessible and eloquent photographs speak to us all. This comprehensive book traces the entire arc of Evans's remarkable career from the 1930s to the 1970s. The illustrations in the book range from his earliest images taken with a vest pocket camera to his final photos using the then new SX 70 because his regular equipment had become too heavy to carry around. The book includes commentary from three of Evans's longtime friends, photographers John T. Hill and Jerry Thompson, and professor emeritus Yale University Alan Trachtenberg. Their insight and first-hand experience give depth to their critical writings on Evans's work. In addition to offering a broad perspective on Evans's work, the book also clarifies the photographer's anti-art philosophy. Eschewing aesthetic hyperbole, Evans wanted his pictures to resonate with a wide audience. At the same time, his natural curiosity made him one of the most inventive photographers of all time. What these photographs and writings attest to is a huge and timeless talent which came not from a camera but from Evans's uniquely hungry eye. *Depth of Field* Walker Evans, John T. Hill, Jr., Heinz Liesbrock, 2015-11-24 Walker Evans, whose work both defined and transcended the genre of documentary photography, is arguably the most influential American photographer of the twentieth century. This first European retrospective of his art will open at the Josef Albers Museum in Bottrop, Germany, in September 2015 and will subsequently travel to the High Museum of Art in Atlanta and to the Vancouver Art Gallery. The accompanying book *Depth of Field* aims to show in detail the arc of Evans's career. It traces the complex development of his oeuvre from the brilliance of his early street photography to his iconic photographs of the Great Depression to his late embrace of color and especially color Polaroid, a medium intended for amateurs. The book also features lesser-known series including his photographs of Victorian and antebellum architecture, Cuba and Florida's Gulf Coast, and his *Fortune* magazine portfolios. Lastly, it sheds light on Evans's appropriation of vernacular signs and ephemera as an extension of his vision with a camera. In image and text, this comprehensive book reveals Evans's denial of photography's boundaries to reach past his time and place, becoming a seminal figure in the arts. *James Agee in Context* Michael A. American Witness RJ Smith, 2017-11-07 From the author of the acclaimed James Brown biography *The One* comes the first in depth biography of renowned photographer and filmmaker Robert Frank best known for his landmark book *The Americans* As well known as Robert Frank the photographer is few can say they really know Robert Frank the man Born and raised in wartime Switzerland Frank discovered the power and allure of photography at an early age and quickly learned that the art meant significantly more to him than the money success or fame The art was all and he intended to spend a lifetime pursuing it *American Witness* is the first comprehensive look at the life of a man who's as mysterious and evasive as he is prolific and gifted Leaving his rigid Switzerland for the more fluid United States in 1947 Frank found himself at the red hot social center of bohemian New York in the 50s and 60s becoming friends with everyone from Jack Kerouac Allen Ginsberg and Peter Orlovsky to photographer Walker Evans actor Zero Mostel painter Willem de Kooning filmmaker Jonas Mekas Bob Dylan writer Rudy Wurlitzer jazz musicians Ornette Coleman and Charles Mingus and more Frank roamed the country with his young family taking roughly 27 000 photographs and collecting 83 of them into what is still his most famous work *The Americans* His was an America nobody had seen before and if it was harshly criticized upon publication for its portrait of a divided country the collection gradually grew to be recognized as a transformative American vision And then he turned his back on certain success giving up photography to reinvent himself as a film and video maker Frank helped found the American independent cinema of the 1960s and made a legendary film with the Rolling Stones Today the nonagenarian is an embodiment of restless creativity and a symbol of what it costs to remain original in America his life defined by never repeating himself never being satisfied *American Witness* is a portrait of a singular artist and the country that he saw
