Hay,2021-12-14 In The Defoliation of America Amy M Hay profiles the attitudes understandings and motivations of grassroots activists who rose to fight the use of phenoxy herbicides commonly known as the Agent Orange chemicals in various aspects of American life during the post WWII era First introduced in 1946 these chemicals mimic hormones in broadleaf plants causing them to essentially grow to death while grass grains and other monocots remain unaffected By the
