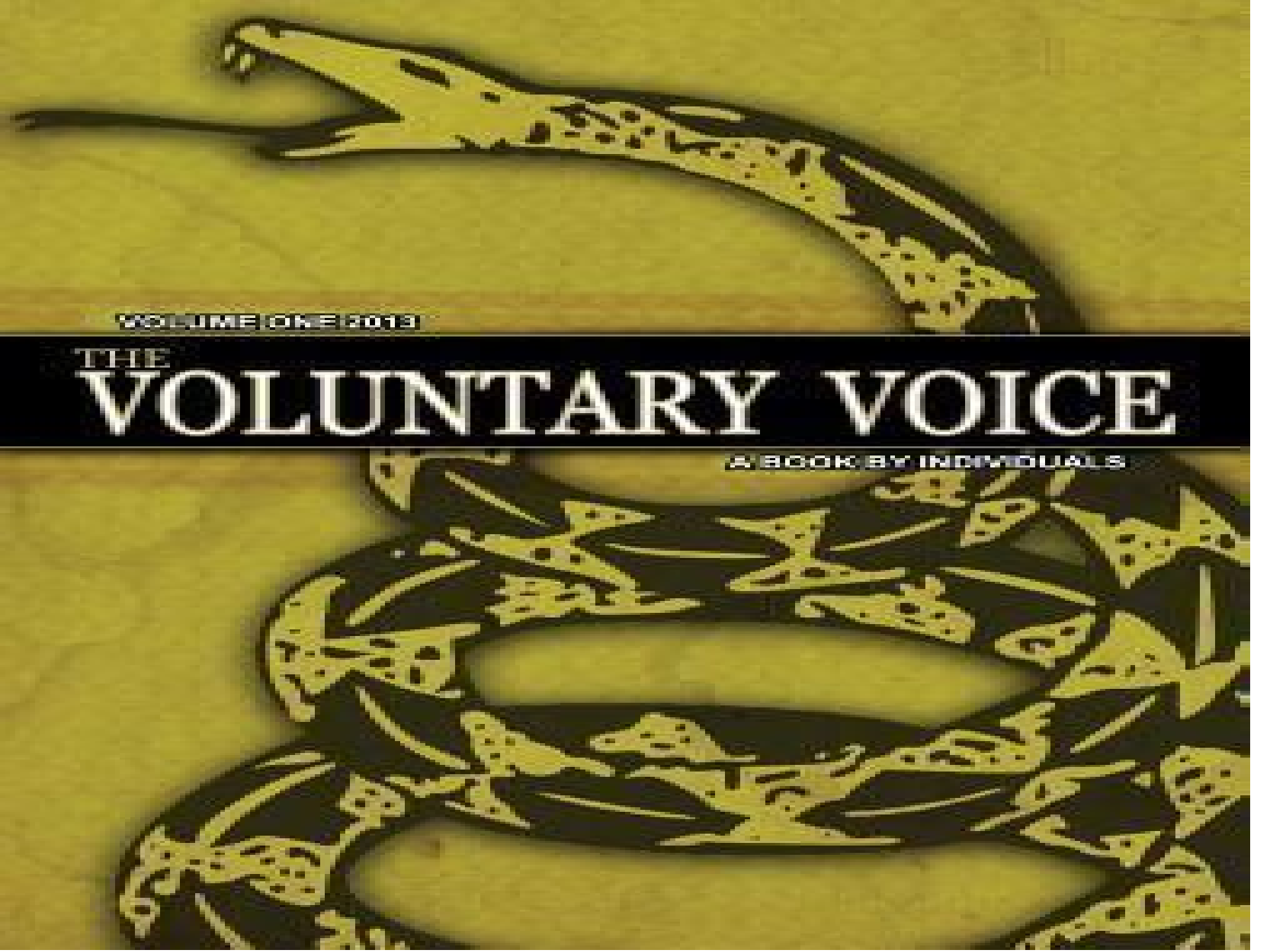

ECHO A Vocal Language Program for Easing Anxiety in Conversation is for clinicians supporting individuals who may experience social anxiety related to speaking in specific situations or with certain individuals. Anxiety has a negative impact on working memory which can make it difficult for individuals to communicate with ease. With reduced experiences talking to a variety of people in various situations speaking often becomes more challenging. The ECHO program was developed to build ease and comfort with social pragmatic communication focusing on improving conversational skills for children from later elementary through teenage years. The program can be implemented by speech language pathologists, psychologists, educators, and other facilitators including parents who support the needs of children and teens with selective mutism, stuttering, and those in need of social communication support. This unique intervention program combines methods of vocalization and verbalization to enhance conversational skills with role play simulations for real life application. Sommer,2016-12-04 Hallucinations can occur across the five sensory modalities auditory visual olfactory tactile and gustatory Whilst they have the potential to be benign or even highly valued they can often be devastating experiences associated with distress impaired social and occupational functioning self harm and suicide Those who experience hallucinations in this latter manner may do so within the context of a wide range of psychiatric diagnoses including schizophrenia bipolar disorder borderline personality disorder and post traumatic stress disorder The only routinely available interventions for people distressed by hallucinations are antipsychotic drugs which date from the introduction of chlorpromazine in the 1950s and manualized cognitive behavioral therapy which originated in the 1990s These interventions do not help all people distressed by hallucinations and in the case of antipsychotic medication come with notable side effects There has hence been great interest in new interventions to support people distressed by hallucinations The goal of this Frontiers Research Topic is to present a collection of papers on new developments in clinical interventions for those distressed by hallucinations In the psychiatric condition that remains most strongly associated with hallucinations schizophrenia the majority 70% of people will have experienced hallucinations in the auditory modality approximately a third will have experienced visual hallucinations and a smaller minority will have experienced hallucinations in other modalities Consistent with this prevalence this collection focusses on auditory and visual hallucinations This is not to minimise the potential distress that can occur from hallucinations in other modalities For example tactile hallucinations particularly when stemming from earlier experiences of sexual abuse can be highly distressing and improved ways to help sufferers of such experiences are also needed In summary this collection aims to result in an interdisciplinary collection of papers which will appeal to a wide readership spanning all with an interest in this area

Social anxiety SA is a common and incapacitating disorder that has been associated with seriously impaired career academic and general social functioning Regarding epidemiological data SA has a lifetime prevalence of 12.1% and is the fourth most

common psychopathological disorder Kessler et al 2005 At a fundamental point of view the most prominent cognitive models of SA posit that biased cognitions contribute to the development and maintenance of the disorder e g Clark Rapee Heimberg 1997 Over the last decades a large body of research has provided evidence that individuals suffering from SA exhibit such biased cognitions at the level of visual attention memory of social encounters interpretation of social events and in judgment of social cues Such biased cognitions in SA has been studied in different ways within cognitive psychology behavioral psychology clinical psychology and cognitive neuroscience over the last few decades yet integrative approaches for channeling all information into a unified account of biased cognitions in SA has not been presented so far The present Research Topic aims to bring together theses different ways and to highlight findings and methods which can unify research across these areas In particular this Research Topic aims to advance the current theoretical models of SA and set the stage for future developments of the field by clarifying and linking theoretical concepts across disciplines
