Further, she juxtaposes the first few lines of the Aeneid in its original Latin with five translations and includes a synopsis of it and a list of dates for quick reference. Aeneid 6 reshaped prior philosophical, religious, and poetic traditions of underworld descents while offering a universalizing account of the spiritual that could accommodate prior as well as emerging religious and philosophical systems. Vergil's underworld became an archetype, a model flexible enough to be employed across genres and periods and among differing cultural and religious contexts.
