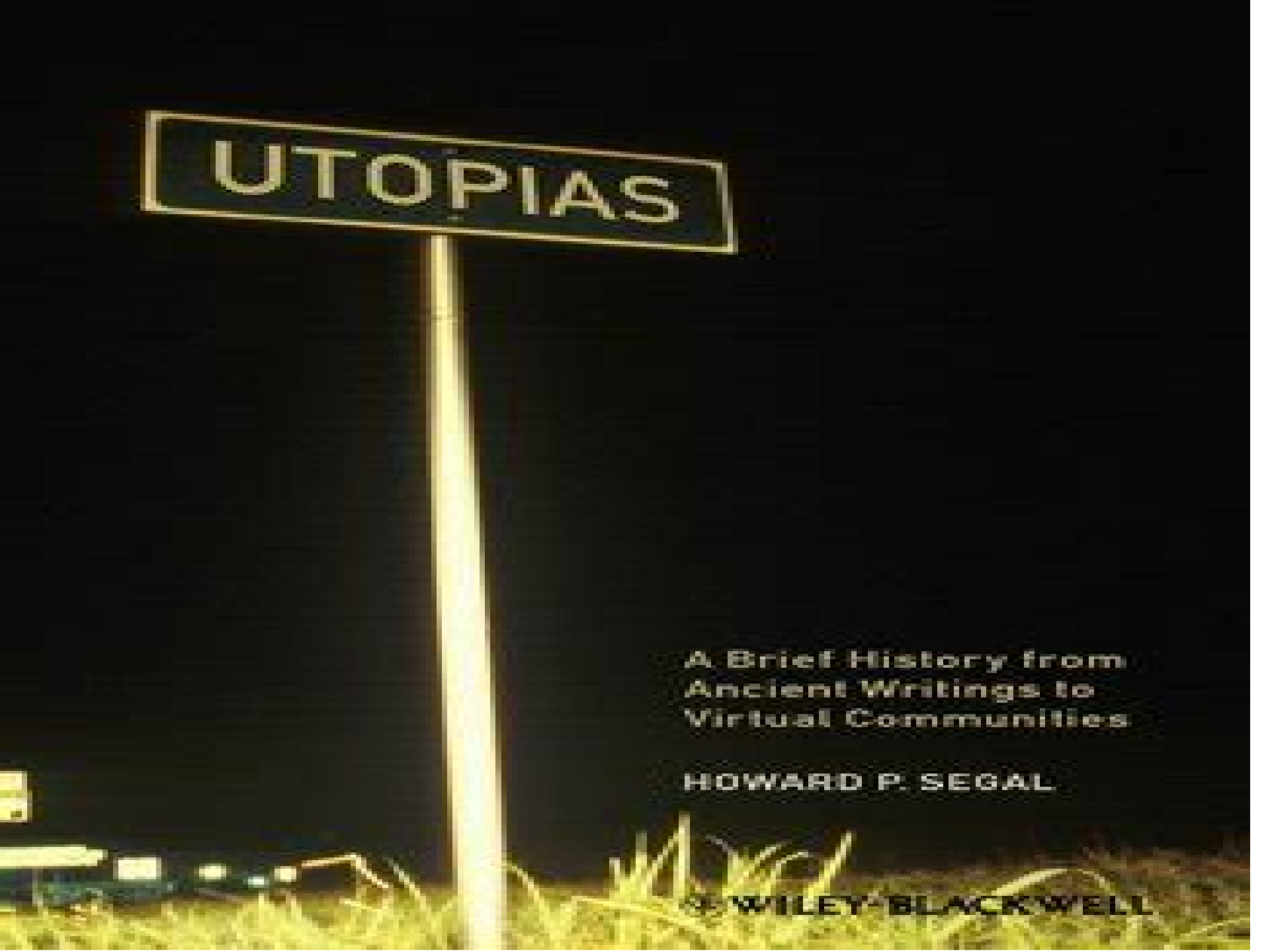

The Nowhere Bible Frauke Uhlenbruch,2015-03-10 The Bible contains passages that allow both scholars and believers to project their hopes and fears onto ever changing empirical realities By reading specific biblical passages as utopia and dystopia this volume raises questions about reconstructing the past the impact of wishful imagination on reality and the hermeneutic implications of dealing with utopia good place yet no place as a method and a concept in biblical studies A believer like William Bradford might approach a biblical passage as utopia by reading it as instructions for bringing about a significantly changed society in reality even at the cost of becoming an oppressor A contemporary biblical scholar might approach the same passage with the ambition of locating the historical reality behind it finding the places it describes on a map or arriving at a conclusion about the social reality experienced by a historical community of redactors These utopian goals are projected onto a utopian text This volume advocates an honest hermeneutical approach to the question of how reliably a past reality can be reconstructed from a biblical passage and it aims to provide an example of disclosing not obscuring pre suppositions brought to the text

called the Ekklessia life in the slum city of Sordesium and it tells the story of the second and third generations of Prophet followers The novel concludes with the story of Victor Dutton and Olivia Preager in the great domed cities of Boston Quebec and Rome Dutton is suspected of conspiracy in the death of the Prophet An investigation follows that reaches into the highest levels of the Pontifical Utopia A number of central characters populate this utopian trilogy among the most important being the mysterious figure of Mecox The story reflects the internal struggles and early evolution of multiple Christianities and the slow emergence of orthodoxy

Utopia Between East and West in Hungarian Literature Zsolt

Czigányik, 2023-01-01 This book focuses on the most important utopian and dystopian literary texts in nineteenth and twentieth century Hungarian literature and therefore widens the scope of the traditionally Anglophone canon Utopian studies is becoming increasingly interdisciplinary and this research integrates literary hermeneutics with ideas and methods from political science and the history of ideas In doing so it argues that Hungarian utopianism was influenced by the region's and Hungarian culture's position of permanent liminality between Western and Eastern European patterns of power structures social and political order After a thorough methodological introduction some early modern texts written in Hungary are discussed while the detailed analyses focus on nineteenth century texts written by Bessenyei Madách and Jókai whereas the twentieth century is represented by Karinthy Babits and Szathmari In the interpretations the results of contemporary scholarship is applied particularly the works of Lyman Tower Sargent Gregory Claeys and Fátima Vieira

Living in the Future Victoria W. Wolcott, 2022-04-21 Victoria W Wolcott argues that utopianism is the little appreciated base of the visionary worldview that informed the prime movers of the Civil Rights Movement Idealism and pragmatism not utopianism are what tend to come to mind when we think about the motivating philosophies of the movement It's well known that many of its iconic moments were carefully executed products of planning not passion alone But Wolcott holds that pragmatism and idealism alike were grounded in nothing less than intensely utopian thought Key figures from Martin Luther King Jr and Coretta Scott to Marjorie Penney and Howard Thurman shared a belief in a radical pacificism that was Wolcott shows both specifically utopian and precisely engaged in changing the existing world Casting mid twentieth century civil rights activism in the light of utopianism ultimately allows us to see the power of dreaming in a profound and concrete fashion one that can be emulated in other times that are desperate for change like today

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
