Veil of Fear Rebecca Theresa Reed, 1999 Rebecca Reed and Maria Monk may not be well known authors today but these women were publishing sensations in nineteenth century America Their lurid tales of life in two North American convents one in Charlestown Massachusetts and the other in Montreal Canada sold more than one half million copies Reed escaped from the Ursuline convent in Charlestown in 1832 Her dramatic renditions of Roman Catholic ritual practice helped spark a night of violence that resulted in the convent being burned to the ground by an angry mob Reed s published narrative *Six Months in a Convent* appeared just as the trials of the rioters were ending in 1835 and became an instant literary success Monk s supporters capitalized on the lucrative market in anti Catholic literature by bringing out the pseudo pornographic *Awful Disclosures of the Hotel Dieu Nunnery in 1836* Monk who claimed her infant daughter had been fathered by a Catholic priest was in fact a Montreal prostitute rather than a nun She enjoyed the life of a literary star in New York before her hoax was uncovered These two narratives are now available for the first time in a single paperback edition Nancy Lusignan Schultz s introduction provides a fascinating glimpse into the history development and marketing of these phenomenal best sellers The convent tales by Reed and Monk are classics that must be read by those interested in American studies popular culture social and religious history literature and women s studies [Sexual Perversions, 1670-1890](#) J. study is to elucidate the nature of these mysterious precincts and above all to demonstrate how they have come to acquire the special qualities they do. In order to do this the author examines the prophetic moment of a people's cultural ethos, the circumstances surrounding that point in time during which their dominant faith acquired its characteristic orifice signature and second to the organizational matters concerning that faith its boundary concerns internal hierarchies and disputes and the external market situation. The author aims to show how the social regulation of bodily orifices is if not mechanically determined at least made understandable in light of religious and theological concerns. These are examined through a social science lens that offers amply illustrated detailed cross cultural studies of orifice taboos in Christianity, ancient Judaism, Brahmanism, tantric Hinduism and some tribal cultures. Aho's argument will add support for the theory that orifices are at the center of all political and religious disputes. James Aho is professor of sociology at Idaho State University. Among his earlier books are two celebrated studies of survivalist and hate groups in the northwest: *The Politics of Righteousness* and *This Thing of Darkness*. Plots, Designs, and Schemes Michael Butter, 2014-05-21 *Plots, Designs, and Schemes* is the first study that investigates the long history of American conspiracy theories from the perspective of literary and cultural studies. Since research in these fields has so far almost exclusively focused on the contemporary period, the book concentrates on the time before 1960. Four detailed case studies offer close readings of the Salem witchcraft crisis of 1692, fears of Catholic invasion during the 1830s to 1850s, antebellum conspiracy theories about slavery and anxieties about Communist subversion during the 1950s. The study primarily engages with factual texts such as sermons, pamphlets, political speeches and confessional narratives but it also analyzes how fears of conspiracy were dramatized and negotiated in fictional texts such as Nathaniel Hawthorne's *Young Goodman Brown* (1835) or Hermann Melville's *Benito Cereno* (1855). The book offers three central insights: 1. The American predilection for conspiracy theorizing can be traced back to the co-presence and persistence of a specific epistemological paradigm that relates all effects to intentional human action, the ideology of republicanism and the Puritan heritage. 2. Until far into the twentieth century, conspiracy theories were considered a perfectly legitimate form of knowledge. As such, they shaped how many Americans, elites as well as common people, understood and reacted to historical events. The Revolutionary War and the Civil War would not have occurred without widespread conspiracy theories. 3. Although most extant research claims the opposite, conspiracy theories have never been as marginal and unimportant as in the past decades. Their disqualification as stigmatized knowledge only occurred around 1960 and coincided with a shift from theories that detect conspiracies directed against the government to conspiracies by the government. *Doubting the Devout* Nora L.
