placed for him on his plate she begins to feel pity and shows so in her face When the stranger notices this his grim expression lights up immediately and he smiles for one brief moment After hearing the story from the stranger of how Simon had kindly robed the stranger after seeing him in his naked state Matryona grabs more of Simon s old clothing and gives it to the stranger
