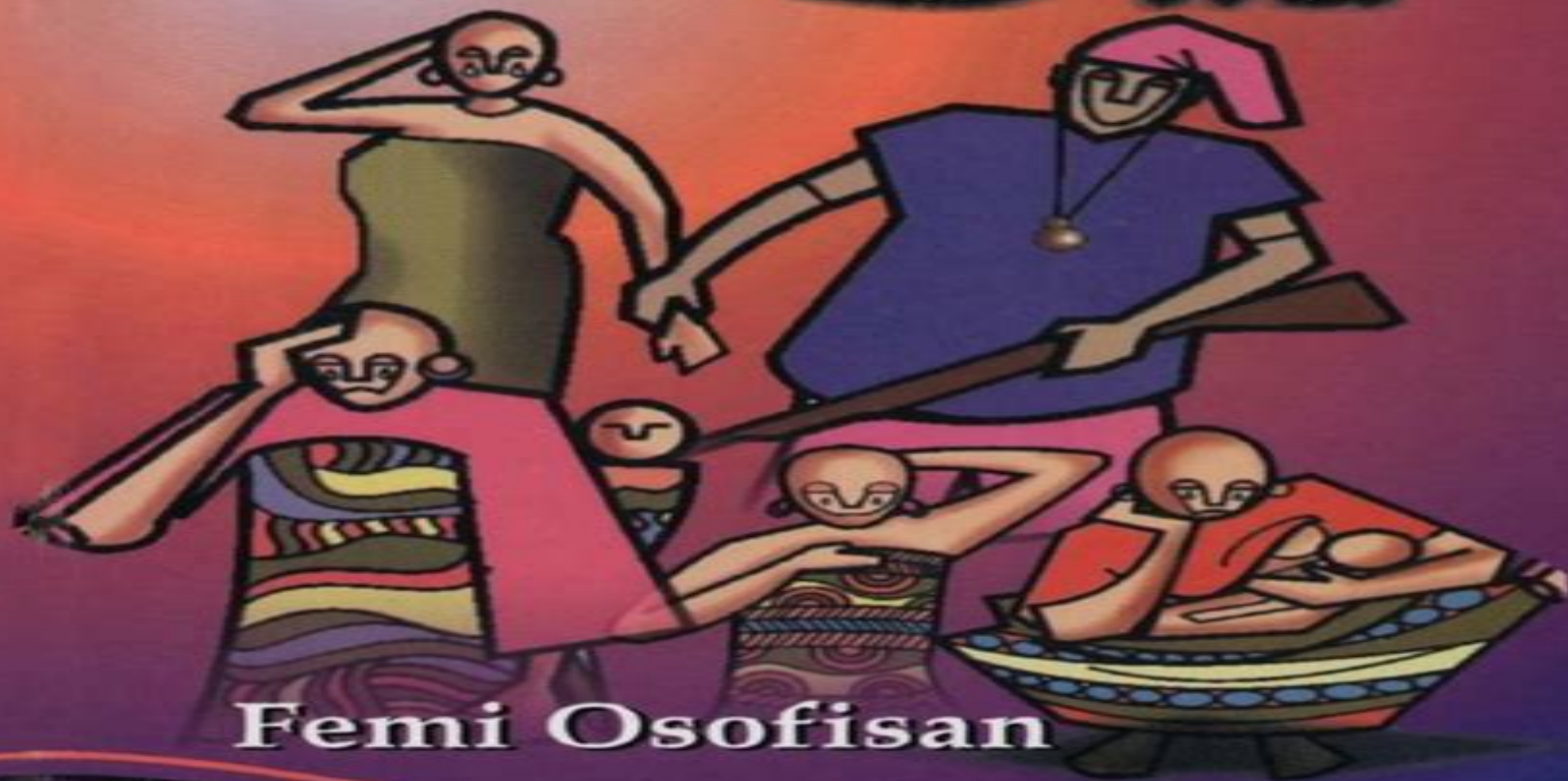

Women Of Owu Characterization:

The Politics of Adaptation Astrid Van Weyenberg, 2013 This book explores contemporary African adaptations of classical Greek tragedies Six South African and Nigerian dramatic texts by Yael Farber Mark Fleishman Athol Fugard Femi Osofisan and Wole Soyinka are analysed through the thematic lens of resistance revolution reconciliation and mourning The opening chapters focus on plays that mobilize Greek tragedy to inspire political change discussing how Sophocles heroine Antigone is reconfigured as a freedom fighter and how Euripides Dionysos is transformed into a revolutionary leader The later chapters shift the focus to plays that explore the costs and consequences of political change examining how the cycle of violence dramatized in Aeschylus Oresteia trilogy acquires relevance in post apartheid South Africa and how the mourning of Euripides Trojan Women resonates in and beyond Nigeria Throughout the emphasis is on how playwrights through adaptation perform a cultural politics directed at the Europe that has traditionally considered ancient Greece as its property foundation and legitimization Van Weyenberg additionally discusses how contemporary African reworkings of Greek tragedies invite us to reconsider how we think about the genre of tragedy and about the cultural process of adaptation Against George Steiner's famous claim that tragedy has died this book demonstrates that Greek tragedy holds relevance today But it also reveals that adaptations do more than simply keeping the texts they draw on alive through adaptation playwrights open up a space for politics In this dynamic between adaptation and pre text the politics of adaptation is performed

Hellenic Common Philip Zapkin, 2021-08-20 Hellenic Common argues that theatrical adaptations of Greek tragedy exemplify the functioning of a cosmopolitan cultural commonwealth Analyzing plays by Femi Osofisan Moira Buffini Marina Carr Colin Teevan and Yael Farber this book shows how contemporary adapters draw tragic and mythic material from a cultural common and remake those stories for modern audiences Phillip Zapkin theorizes a political economy of adaptation combining both a formal reading of adaptation as an aesthetic practice and a political reading of adaptation as a form of resistance Drawing an ethical centre from Kwame Anthony Appiah's work on cosmopolitanism and Michael Hardt and Antonio Negri's theory of the common Hellenic Common argues that Attic tragedy forms a cultural commonwealth from which dramatists the world over can rework reimagine and restage materials to envision aspirational new worlds through the arts This study will be of great interest to students and scholars of drama adaptation studies literature and neoliberalism

Portrayals of Masculinity in Nigerian Plays Beatrice Nwawuloke Onuoha, 2023-10-16 Portrayals of Masculinity in Nigerian Plays explores Nigerian people's notions of masculinity as portrayed in twelve Nigerian plays written by three generations of Nigerian playwrights She argues that hegemonic masculinity and other forms which are referred to as alternative masculinities exist in traditional Nigerian society By analyzing plays written by first second and third generation Nigerian playwrights Onuoha tracks how notions about masculinity have evolved over the years Further she discusses the malleability of masculinity by exploring how women manifest qualities associated with masculinity within Nigerian plays Through a

review of critical studies on gender constructions Onuoha examines not only the negative experiences of women within an African patriarchal system but also the negative experiences of the men who are also direct or indirect victims of such a system

Re-writing Pasts, Imagining Futures Gomia, Victor N., Ndi, Gilbert Shang, 2018-02-20 The papers in this volume focus on fiction and theatre in their traditional forms as well as in their encounters with novel and innovative forms and avenues of dissemination As a cultural practice that emerged from a process of protest and contestation of hegemony it is understandable that one main concern in African literature and literary criticism is the resistance against the emergence of marginalizing centers in formerly or currently marginalized societies with regard to discourses aesthetics and media of creation These new centers that sometimes undermine the strategic tactical exploitation of the relative advantage procured by each medium run the risk of leading to new forms of stratification that mitigate the import of African and African diasporic literatures The collection of essays therefore seeks to analyze the representation of pertinent socio political and historical questions in a variety of postcolonial texts from Africa and the African diasporas notably the Caribbean islands and the United States of America However far from re writing of history in a way that cedes to conservative worldviews creative writers and critics simultaneously attempt to chart ways forward for socially all inclusive futures In the context of colonial and neo colonial legacies that seem to forestall any sense of individual and collective self fulfillment contributors to this volume examine the pertinence of African fiction and theatre in imagining new vistas of re conceptualizing the postcolonial condition in ways that re galvanize the belief in an enabling future
