Treatment of Psychological Disorders

An overview of the various approaches of treatment of psychological disorders include: Behaviorist, Humanistic, Psychoanalytic/Psychodynamic, Gestalt, Cognitive-Behavioral, and Pharmacological. We will also look at the various modes in which therapy can be administered such as the one-on-one approach of Cognitive Psychotherapy or group therapy, as in support or family therapies. Therapy may also be administered on an outpatient basis like a counseling center, or within a hospital or institutional setting. Additionally, students will be exposed to prevention and intervention techniques offered at the community level. Such services include educational programs, crisis intervention, telephone hotlines, and counseling.
