Morten Høi Jensen, 2025-10-21 The arresting story of how Thomas Mann wrote *The Magic Mountain* as a defeated Germany descended into political chaos Like many writers of his generation Thomas Mann 1875 1955 welcomed the outbreak of the First World War He viewed it as a spiritual necessity a chance to reassert German cultural dominance over Western ideas of democracy and enlightenment Then in 1924 he published *The Magic Mountain* a massive novel that culminates in the slaughter of war and foreshadows the Nazi terror to come One of the central achievements of modernism *The Magic Mountain* bears testimony to its author s dramatic political reorientation as a defender of democracy This poignant book is a biography of Mann s great novel its evolution from a short story into a two volume masterpiece and one of the bestselling novels of the Weimar era Deftly weaving together elements of biography history and literary criticism Morten H i Jensen reveals how writing *The Magic Mountain* against a backdrop of world war revolution hyperinflation and rising right wing

terror moved Mann to embrace the democratic and humanistic ideas he once scorned One hundred years after *The Magic Mountain* was first published at a time when democratic ideas are again under threat Jensen reveals the universality and timeliness of Mann's great novel its still resonant debates over democracy and tyranny time and place illness and death

Robert Burton and the Transformative Powers of Melancholy Stephanie Shirilan, 2016-03-03 Few English books are as widely known underread and underappreciated as Robert Burton's *The Anatomy of Melancholy* Stephanie Shirilan laments that modern scholars often treat the *Anatomy* as an unmediated repository of early modern views on melancholy overlooking the fact that Burton is writing a cento an ancient form of satire that quotes and misquotes authoritative texts in often subversive ways and that his express intent in so doing is to offer his readers literary therapy for melancholy This book explores the ways in which the *Anatomy* dispenses both direct physic and more systemic medicine by encouraging readers to think of melancholy as a privileged mental and spiritual acuity that requires cultivation and management rather than cure Refuting the prevailing historiography of anxious early modern embodiment that cites Burton as a key witness Shirilan submits that the *Anatomy* rejects contemporary Neostoic and Puritan approaches to melancholy She reads Burton's erraticism opacity and theatricality as modes of resistance against demands for constancy transparency and plainness in the popular literature of spiritual and moral hygiene of his day She shows how Burton draws on rhetorical theological and philosophical traditions that privilege the transformative powers of the imagination in order to celebrate melancholic impressionability for its capacity to inspire and engender empathy charity and faith

Another Christ Andrew D. Family and Borghesia Natalia Ginzburg, 2021-04-13 Two novellas about domestic life isolation and the passing of time by one of the finest Italian writers of the twentieth century Carmine an architect and Ivana a translator lived together long ago and even had a child but the child died and their relationship fell apart and Carmine married Ninetta and their child is Dod who Carmine feels is a little dull and these days Carmine is still spending every evening with Ivana but Ninetta has nothing to say about that Family the first of these two novellas from the 1970s is an

examination at first comic then progressively dark about how time passes and life goes on and people circle around the opportunities they had missed missing more as they do until finally time is up Borghesia about a widow who keeps acquiring and losing the Siamese cats she hopes will keep her company in her loneliness explores similar ground along with the confusions of feeling and domestic life that came with the loosening social strictures of the 1970s She remembered saying that there were three things in life you should always refuse thinks one of Natalia Ginzburg s characters beginning to age out of youth Hypocrisy resignation and unhappiness But it was impossible to shield yourself from those three things Life was full of them and there was no holding them back

Race and the Totalitarian Century Vaughn Rasberry,2016-10-03 Vaughn Rasberry turns to black culture and politics for an alternative history of the totalitarian century He shows how black writers reimagined the standard antifascist anticommunist narrative through the lens of racial injustice with the U S as a tyrannical force in the Third World but also an agent of Asian and African independence The Road Vasiliĭ Semenovich

The White Bear Henrik Pontoppidan, 2025-06-10 Love faith and the political mingle in these two short novels by a Nobel Prize winning Danish author One about a young couple making a new life in Rome the other about a priest who goes to live among native peoples in Greenland both books explore the reaches of the human heart through their complex and unforgettable characters Henrik Pontoppidan the Danish Nobel laureate is admired for the concentrated force of his novellas as much as for long populous world encompassing novels like *A Fortunate Man* and here are two of those novellas newly and brilliantly translated by Paul Larkin *The White Bear* follows the fate of the odd gangly red bearded Thorkild Møller Born in rural Jutland and destined for the ministry Thorkild proves to be a poor student and is assigned to a remote Inuit tribe in Greenland There with his mythic looking staff and dogskin skullcap he becomes known as the White Bear a beloved legend among the locals and a freewheeling embarrassment to his fellow priests Grown old he returns to Denmark where again his flock adores him while his fellow men of cloth try to tame the whirling dervish in their midst In the end Thorkild mysteriously disappears presumably back to the snow wilderness of Greenland *The Rearguard* on the other hand is a marriage story Newlyweds Jørgen Hallager and Ursula Branth are as different as night and day The brash son of a poor village teacher Jørgen is an avowed socialist whose revolutionary beliefs translate into his work as a painter of social realism Ursula comes from a conservative upper middle class family At first as they start their married life in Rome they each try to change the other's worldview with arguments and threats but as time wears on and they wear each other down it becomes clear there can be no reconciliation It is a tragic tale of art and idealism individuality and love This translation was funded in part by a grant from the Danish Arts Foundation [Saturday Review of Literature](#) ,1925
