Thomas Hardy: Selected Poems 2nd Edition Neil Wenborn, 2025-11-11 Thomas Hardy is unique in English literature as a major novelist who is also a major poet His collected poetry includes such pinnacles of the lyric tradition as *The Darkling* *Thrush* and the series of haunted love elegies written in memory of his first wife Emma as well as such classics of the late Victorian and early twentieth century canon as *Drummer Hodge* and *The Convergence of the Twain* Among the most distinctive bodies of verse in the language it is also among the most controversial Ever since it first appeared in Wessex

Poems in 1898 readers and critics have stumbled over its awkwardnesses or been seduced by its idiosyncratic music have celebrated its unprecedented formal inventiveness or deplored its perceived lack of ambition It has been variously read as an archetype of the Victorian intellectual odyssey as the work of a proto modernist and as the fountainhead of contemporary British verse At once traditional and modern the acme of artifice and a conduit of intense emotion it remains a critical enigma This revised edition of Neil Wenborn's exemplary study guide sets Hardy's poetry in the context of his life times and literary heritage and explores through a close reading of selected poems the challenge it offers to criticism and the elusive power it continues to exert over each new generation of readers Significantly expanded to provide detailed introductions to Hardy's eight collections including *Time's Laughingstocks* *Moments of Vision* and *Satires of Circumstance* it references some 330 poems and features a number of new close readings chosen to illuminate key characteristics of his oeuvre as a whole together with an updated overview of critical works and approaches and an expanded glossary and bibliography
