vivendi with such regimes in Nazi Germany and Fascist Italy it found such accommodation increasingly difficult to maintain in the face of ever more aggressive challenges to its rights by Nazi Germany and Fascist Italy After a series of protests made against such infringements of its prerogatives the Vatican felt it necessary to issue two encyclicals opposing the policies of Mussolini and Hitler Non Abbiamo Bisogno in 1931 and Mit Brennender Sorge in 1937 respectively Mit Brennender Sorge included criticisms of Nazism and racism However the exigencies of the geopolitical situation constrained the ability of the Vatican to act in opposition to these regimes The Bavarian region the Rhineland and Westphalia as well as parts in south west Germany were predominantly Catholic and the church had previously enjoyed a degree of privilege there North Germany was heavily Protestant and Catholics had suffered
