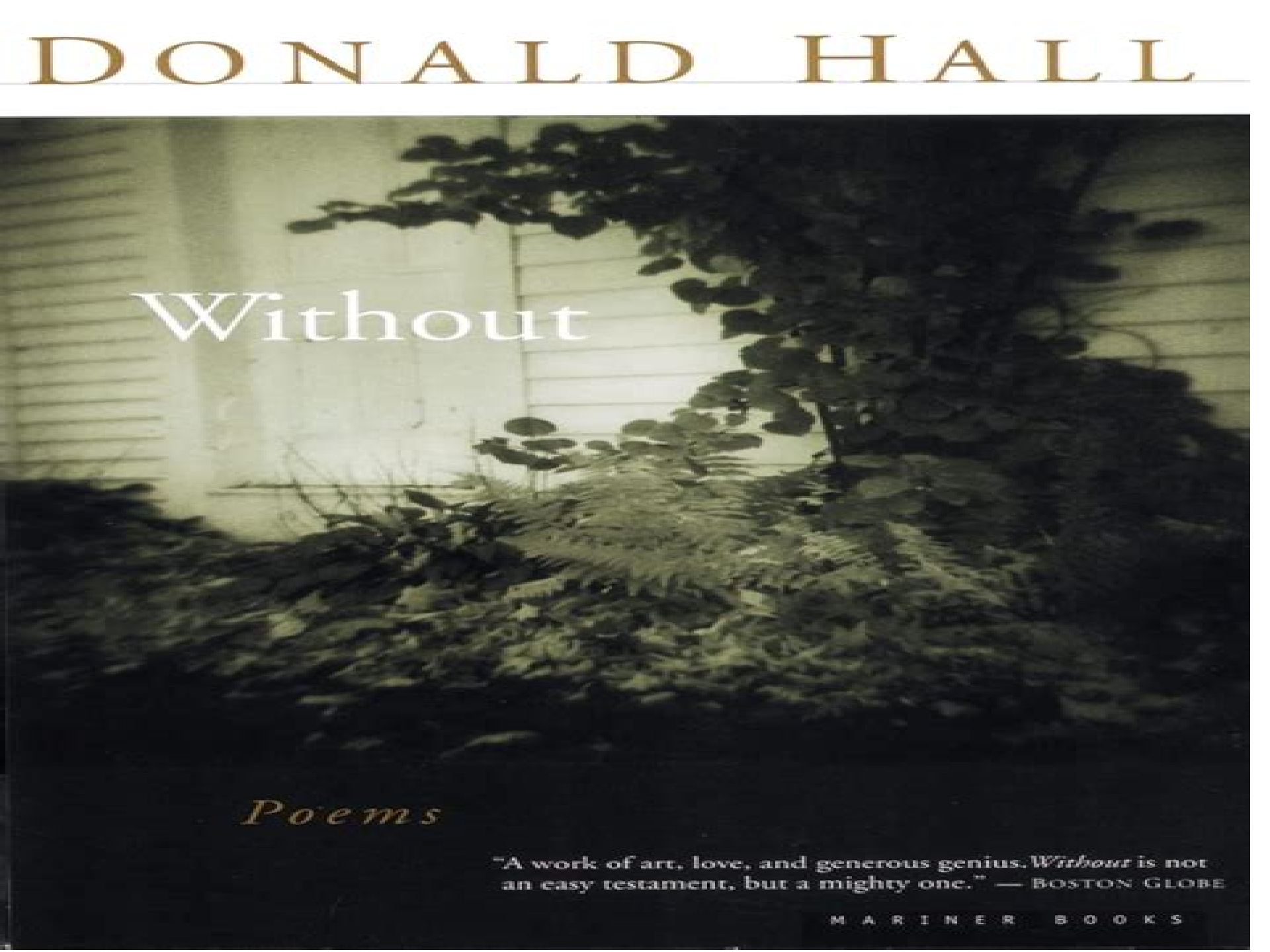

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Jane Kenyon Dana Greene, 2023-10-10 Demystifying the Poet Laureate of Depression Pleasure loving sarcastic stubborn determined erotic deeply sad Jane Kenyon's complexity and contradictions found expression in luminous poems that continue to attract a passionate following Dana Greene draws on a wealth of personal correspondence and other newly available materials to delve into the origins achievement and legacy of Kenyon's poetry and separate the artist's life story from that of her husband the award winning poet Donald Hall Impacted by relatives depression during her isolated childhood Kenyon found poetry at college where writers like Robert Bly encouraged her development Her graduate school marriage to the middle aged Hall and subsequent move to New Hampshire had an enormous impact on her life moods and creativity Immersed in poetry Kenyon wrote about women's lives nature death mystical experiences and melancholy becoming in her own words an advocate of the inner life Her breakthrough in the 1980s brought acclaim as a born poet and appearances in the New Yorker and elsewhere Yet her ongoing success and artistic growth exacerbated strains in her marriage and failed to stave off depressive episodes that sometimes left her non functional Refusing to live out the stereotype of the mad woman poet Kenyon sought treatment and confronted her illness in her work and in public while redoubling her personal dedication to finding pleasure in every fleeting moment Prestigious fellowships high profile events residencies and media interviews had propelled her career to new heights when leukemia cut her life short and left her husband the loving but flawed curator of her memory and legacy Revelatory and insightful Jane Kenyon offers the first full length biography of the elusive poet and the unquiet life that shaped her art

The Rebirth of the Clinic Daniel P. Sulmasy, 2006-05-19 The Rebirth of the Clinic begins with a bold assertion the doctor patient relationship is sick Fortunately as this engrossing book demonstrates the damage is not irreparable Today patients voice their desires to be seen not just as bodies but as whole people Though not willing to give up scientific progress and all it has to offer they sense the need for more Patients want a form of medicine that can heal them in body and soul This movement is reflected in medical school curricula in which courses in spirituality and health care are taught alongside anatomy and physiology But how can health care workers translate these concepts into practice How can they strike an appropriate balance integrating and affirming spirituality without abandoning centuries of science or unwittingly adopting pseudoscience Physician and philosopher Daniel Sulmasy is uniquely qualified to guide readers through this terrain At the outset of this accessible engaging volume he explores the nature of illness and healing focusing on health care's rich history as a spiritual practice and on the human dignity of the patient Combining sound theological reflection with doses of healthy skepticism he goes on to describe empirical research on the effects of spirituality on health including scientific studies of the healing power of prayer emphasizing that there are reasons beyond even promising research data to attend to the souls of patients Finally Sulmasy devotes special attention and compassion to the care of people at the end of life incorporating the stories of several of his patients Throughout the author never strays from the theme that for physicians

in science or secularism the authors of *Heal Thyself* one a theological ethicist the other a physician instead challenge the basic precepts of the movement from the standpoint of Christian theology *Heal Thyself* argues that popular culture's fascination with the health benefits of religion reflects not the renaissance of religious tradition but the powerful combination of consumer capitalism and self interested individualism A faith for health exchange misrepresents and devalues the true meaning of faith For Christians being religious does not mean enlisting faith as a vehicle to get what we want be it health or wealth but rather learning by faith to want the right things at the right time and to live with a spirit of gratitude and hope

Nations of Nothing But Poetry Matthew Hart, 2010-04-22 Modernism is typically associated with novelty and urbanity So what happens when poets identify small communities and local languages with the spirit of transnational modernity Are vernacular poetries inherently provincial or implicitly xenophobic How did modernist poets use vernacular language to re imagine the relations between people their languages and the communities in which they live *Nations of Nothing But Poetry* answers these questions through case studies of British Caribbean and American poetries from the 1920s through the 1990s With a combination of fresh insights and attentive close readings Matthew Hart presents a new theory of a synthetic vernacular writing that explores the aesthetic and ideological tensions within modernism's dual commitments to the local and the global The result is an invigorating contribution to the field of transnational modernist studies Chapters focus on a mixture of canonical and non canonical writers combining new literary histories such as the story of how Melvin B Tolson while a resident of Oklahoma was appointed Poet Laureate of Liberia with analyses of poems by Gertrude Stein W H Auden Ezra Pound and T S Eliot More broadly the book reveals how the language of modernist poetry was shaped by the incompletely globalized nature of a world in which the nation state continued to be a primary mediator of cultural and political identity even as its authority was challenged as never before Through deft juxtaposition Hart develops a new interpretation of modernist poetry in English one that disrupts the critical opposition between nationalism and the transnational paving the way for a political history of modernist cosmopolitanism

The CIA and the Congress for Cultural Freedom in the Early Cold War Sarah Miller Harris, 2016-08-05 This book questions the conventional wisdom about one of the most controversial episodes in the Cold War and tells the story of the CIA's backing of the Congress for Cultural Freedom For nearly two decades during the early Cold War the CIA secretly sponsored some of the world's most feted writers philosophers and scientists as part of a campaign to prevent Communism from regaining a foothold in Western Europe and from spreading to Asia By backing the Congress for Cultural Freedom the CIA subsidized dozens of prominent magazines global congresses annual seminars and artistic festivals When this operation QKOPERA became public in 1967 it ignited one of the most damaging scandals in CIA history Ever since then many accounts have argued that the CIA manipulated a generation of intellectuals into lending their names to pro American anti Communist ideas Others have suggested a more nuanced picture of the relationship between the Congress and the CIA with intellectuals sometimes

resisting the CIA's bidding Very few accounts however have examined the man who held the Congress together Michael Josselson the Congress's indispensable manager and secretly a long time CIA agent This book fills that gap Using a wealth of archival research and interviews with many of the figures associated with the Congress this book sheds new light on how the Congress came into existence and functioned both as a magnet for prominent intellectuals and as a CIA operation This book will be of much interest to students of the CIA Cold War History intelligence studies US foreign policy and International Relations in general
