Woman Between Mirrors:

Woman Between Mirrors Helena Parente Cunha, 1992 *Acts of Narrative Resistance* Laura J. Beard, 2009-10-01 This exploration of women's autobiographical writings in the Americas focuses on three specific genres: testimonio, metafiction, and the family saga as the story of a nation. What makes Laura J. Beard's work distinctive is her pairing of readings of life narratives by women from different countries and traditions. Her section on metafiction focuses on works by Helena Parente Cunha of Brazil and Luisa Futoran of Argentina; the family sagas explored are by Ana María Shua and Nilda Piñón of Argentina and Brazil respectively; and the section on testimonio highlights narratives by Lee Maracle and Shirley Sterling from different Indigenous nations in British Columbia. In these texts, Beard terms genres of resistance: women resist the cultural definitions imposed upon them in an effort to speak and name their own experiences. The author situates her work in the context of not only other feminist studies of women's autobiographies but also the continuing study of inter-American literature that is demanding more comparative and cross-cultural approaches. *Acts of Narrative Resistance* addresses prominent issues in the fields of autobiography, comparative literature, and women's studies and in inter-American, Latin American, and Native American studies.

Citizen Bacchae Barbara Goff, 2004-06-14 What activities did the women of ancient Greece perform in the sphere of ritual, and what were the meanings of such activities for them and their culture? By offering answers to these questions, this study aims to recover and reconstruct an important dimension of the lived experience of ancient Greek women. A comprehensive and sophisticated investigation of the ritual roles of women in ancient Greece, it draws on a wide range of evidence from across the Greek world, including literary and historical texts, inscriptions, and vase paintings, to assemble a portrait of women as religious and cultural agents despite the ideals of seclusion within the home and exclusion from public arenas that we know restricted their lives. As she builds a picture of the extent and diversity of women's ritual activity, Barbara Goff shows that they were entrusted with some of the most important processes by which the community guaranteed its welfare. She examines the ways in which women's ritual activity addressed issues of sexuality and civic participation, showing that ritual could offer women genuinely alternative roles and identities even while it worked to produce wives and mothers who functioned well in this male-dominated society. Moving to more speculative analysis, she discusses the possibility of a women's subculture focused on ritual and investigates the significance of ritual in women's poetry and vase paintings that depict women. She also includes a substantial exploration of the representation of women as ritual agents in fifth-century Athenian drama.

Violence and the Female Imagination Paula Ruth Gilbert, 2006-03-31 In the past twenty years, Quebec women writers, including Aline Chamberland, Claire D'Suzanne, and Hélène Rioux, have created female characters who are fascinated with bold sexual actions and language, cruelty, and violence at times culminating in infanticide and serial killing. Paula Ruth Gilbert argues that these Quebec feminist writers are re-framing gender. *Violence and the Female Imagination* explores whether these imagined women are striking out at an external other or

harming themselves through acts of self destruction and depression Gilbert examines the degree to which women are imitating men in the outward direction of their anger and hostility and suggests that such tough women may be mocking men in their macho exploits of sexuality and violence She illustrates the ways in which Quebec female authors are feminizing violence or re envisioning gender in North American culture Gilbert bridges methodological gaps and integrates history sociology literary theory feminist theory and other disciplinary approaches to provide a framework for the discussion of important ethical and aesthetic questions

Gender, Discourse, and Desire in Twentieth-Century Brazilian Women's Literature Cristina Ferreira-Pinto, 2004-02-01 This study by Cristina Ferreira Pinto explores the poetic and narrative strategies twentieth century Brazilian women writers use to achieve new forms of representation of the female body sexuality and desire Female writers discussed include Gilka Machado Lygia Fagundes Telles Marcia Denser and Marina Colasanti While creating new forms these writers are also deconstructing cultural myths of femininity and female behavior In order to understand these myths the book also presents new readings of some male authored canonical novels by Jose de Alencar Machado de Assis Manuel Antonio de Almeida and Aluisio Azevedo The specific focus on female sexuality and desire acknowledges the intrinsic link between sexuality and an individual s sense of identity and its importance for female identity given the historical repression of women s bodies and the double standard of morality still pervasive in many Western cultures In the discussion of the strategies Brazilian female poets and fiction writers employ Ferreira Pinto addresses some social and cultural issues that relate to a woman s sense of her own body and sexuality the characterization of women based on racial features and class hierarchy marriage motherhood the silencing of the lesbian subject and aging Ferreira Pinto s analysis is informed by the
