She also decodes their collective narrative chronology, which begins in the late seventeenth century and ends in the late twentieth century, as Morrison delineates three hundred years of African American experience. In Furman's view, Morrison tells new and difficult stories of old, familiar histories, such as the making of Colonial America and the racing of American society. In the final chapters, Furman pays particular attention to form, noting Morrison's continuing practice of the kind of deep novelistic structure that transcends plot and imparts much of a novel's meaning.
