University of Nebraska-Omaha Football Darren Ivy, 2015-10-19 From its inaugural season in 1911 through its final season in 2011 the University of Nebraska Omaha football team always faced an uphill struggle in terms of resources The program reached a pinnacle in 1954 with its lone unbeaten season Many other teams and individuals also found great success winning conference titles and bowl games and moving onto professional careers Just because the school no longer offers football it does not mean that the thousands of men who played for the Mavericks from 1971 to 2011 the Indians from 1939 to 1971 and the Cardinals and the Maroons before should not be remembered and honored for the years they poured their hearts and souls into the Omaha football program [Women's American Football](#) Russ Crawford, 2022-11 Tackle football has been primarily viewed as a male sport but at a time when men's participation rates are decreasing an increasing number of women are entering the gridiron and they have a long history of doing so Women's American Football is a narrative history of girls and women participating in American football in the United States since the 1920s when a women's team played at halftime during an early NFL game The women's game became more organized in 1974 when the National Women's Football League was established with notable teams such as the Dallas Bluebonnets Toledo Troopers Oklahoma City Dolls and Detroit Demons Today there are two main professional leagues in the United States the Women's Football Alliance with nearly seventy teams and the Women's National Football Conference with eighteen in addition to a number of smaller leagues The National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics and the NFL have recently begun sponsoring flag football teams at the college level and the game is growing for high school girls as well In 2021 more than two thousand girls played on mostly boys teams and there are currently four all girls leagues in the United States and Canada in Manitoba Utah Indiana and New Brunswick In addition to the rapid growth of women playing football there have been advancements in other areas of the game Beginning with Jennifer Welter in 2015 several women have earned positions coaching the professional game In 2020 ESPN aired Born to Play a documentary on the Boston Renegades the 2019 champion of the Women's Football Alliance Based on extensive interviews with women players and focusing closely on leagues teams and athletes since the passage of Title IX in 1972 Russ Crawford illuminates the rich history of the women who have played football breaking barriers on and off the field **Blue-Eyed Soul Brother** William C. Kashatus, **George Allen** Michael Richman, 2023-11 George Allen was a fascinating and eccentric figure in the world of football coaching His remarkable career spanned six decades from the late 1940s until his sudden death in 1990 at the age of seventy three Although he never won a Super Bowl he never had a losing season as an NFL head coach and was inducted into the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 2002 In George Allen A Football Life Mike Richman captures the life and accomplishments of one of the most successful NFL coaches of all time and one of the greatest innovators in the game A player's coach Allen was a tremendous motivator and game strategist as well as a defensive mastermind and is credited with making special teams a critical focus in an era in

which they were an afterthought He had a keen eye for talent and pulled off masterful trades often for veteran players who were viewed to be past their prime who then had great seasons and made his teams much better In addition to his coaching feats Allen had an idiosyncratic and controversial personality His life revolved around football 24 7 One of his quirks was to minimize chewing time by consuming soft foods giving himself more time to prepare for games and study opponents He lived and breathed football he compared losing to death Allen had contentious relationships with the owners of the two NFL teams for which he was the head coach the Washington Redskins and Los Angeles Rams Richman explores why he was fired by those teams and whether he was blackballed from coaching again in the NFL Based on detailed research and interviews with family former players and coaches George Allen is the definitive biography of the football coach who lived to win loved a good challenge and left a lasting legacy on pro football history

The Team That History Forgot Rick Gosselin, 2025-11 While the Kansas City Chiefs are the NFL's newest dynasty winning three Super Bowls since 2020 most fans don't recall the team's earliest successful years before decades of futility What about the underdog losers of that very first Super Bowl When the Kansas City Chiefs played the Green Bay Packers in Super Bowl I in 1967 they had only been in existence for seven seasons and were tasked with the monumental burden of representing the still fledgling American Football League against the NFL's team of the decade The Chiefs won their first AFL Championship in 1962 as the Dallas Texans when owner Lamar Hunt decided the Dallas market couldn't support two pro football teams it could barely support one After just three seasons the Texans relocated to Kansas City where they became the Chiefs Under future Hall of Famers Len Dawson Buck Buchanan and Johnny Robinson they were the winningest AFL team and helped integrate pro football more than any other team in the 1960s In *The Team That History Forgot* Rick Gosselin explores the team's struggles and triumphs in its early years the competition created by the AFL in player signing wars the recruitment of athletes from historically Black colleges and universities the loss of the franchise identity with the move from Texas to Kansas City the first Super Bowl and the humiliating loss against the Packers and the moves the Chiefs made to recover from that loss and win Super Bowl IV the last game before the two rival leagues finally merged in 1970 The early Chiefs set a bar for excellence that the team continues to pursue today

Behind the Yoi Dan Joseph, **Pioneer Coaches of the NFL** John Maxymuk, 2019-08-09 In the early days of professional football coaches were little more than on field captains who also ran practices if there was time for practice The emergence of post graduate football and the coaching profession from 1920 to 1950 was crucial to the evolution of the game and both developed and rose in stature over this critical period in the history of football In *Pioneer Coaches of the NFL Shaping the Game in the Days of Leather Helmets and 60 Minute Men* John Maxymuk profiles some of the most innovative coaches from the early days of the NFL including Guy Chamberlin Curly Lambeau George Halas Patsy Clark and Clark Shaughnessy Along with biographical sketches and career details the profiles examine the coaches strategic approaches their impact on the history of the game and the advancement of their roles both on and off the field It was this

group of coaches who initially devised the basic repertoire of plays and alignments as well as passing routes blocking schemes shifts and substitution patterns These men morphed defensive alignments introduced the four man secondary conceived zone and man to man coverage mixes and concocted linebacker and safety blitzing Pioneer Coaches of the NFL details how coaches from the first three decades of the NFL established many of the procedures conventions and strategies that modern football coaches still use today These innovators presented those that followed them a rich palate with which to imagine and create an even greater game

Nebraska Cornhusker Football Mark Fricke,2005 When Matt Davison made a diving catch on the famous flea flicker play against Missouri in 1997 securing Nebraska s perfect season the Husker faithful were in football nirvana And that memorable play was preceded by over a century of Nebraska Football greatness The team was winning conference championships back in the 1890s and was an established national powerhouse by the time they joined the Big Eight later Big Twelve in 1928 Even the mediocre years brought excitement such as the stunning 25 21 upset of the unbeatable Sooners in 1959 Five National Championships 1970 71 94 95 and 97 under the coaching of Bob Devaney and Tom Osborne when the Huskers won at least 9 games per season for over 30 straight years is an accomplishment of which most collegiate football programs can only dream
