center for worship The Chronicler stresses the importance of re remembering our story in the right way in order to understand who we are in this new life The practices that sustained the people in exile will define a people who weren told enough to remember life before exile Episode 23 Apocalyptic Daniel Apocalyptic literature is not primarily about future events It looks at traumatic events in the present and finds a divine plan at work By using vivid symbols and imagery the court tales and visions of Daniel stress that God is ultimately controls human events.
