**Chapter 2 of Thinking Points** , But in a human brain both can exist side by side, each neurally inhibiting the other and structuring different areas of experience. 1 It is hardly unnatural or unusual to be fiscally conservative and socially progressive or to support a liberal domestic policy and a conservative foreign policy or to have a conservative view of the market and a progressive view of civil liberties. For instance, religious Christians, both Catholics and Protestants, are progressives at heart if they believe they should live their lives according to the teachings of Christ: help the poor, feed the hungry, cure the sick, forgive the sinner, turn the other cheek. The four predominant myths of the center: the Label myth, the Linear myth, the Moderate myth, and the Mainstream myth, all assume that people vote on the basis of a candidate's positions on the issues. This myth lurks behind the idea of the center and fosters the belief that progressives must move toward the right and abandon or hide their progressive ideology if they are to succeed. The theory is that moving rightward leaves more voters to the left of the candidate, making the candidate appear more well-moderate. This runs contrary to the biconceptual view that it is best to communicate and appeal to swing voters by activating their partial progressive identities with a progressive vision and appropriate progressive language.
