

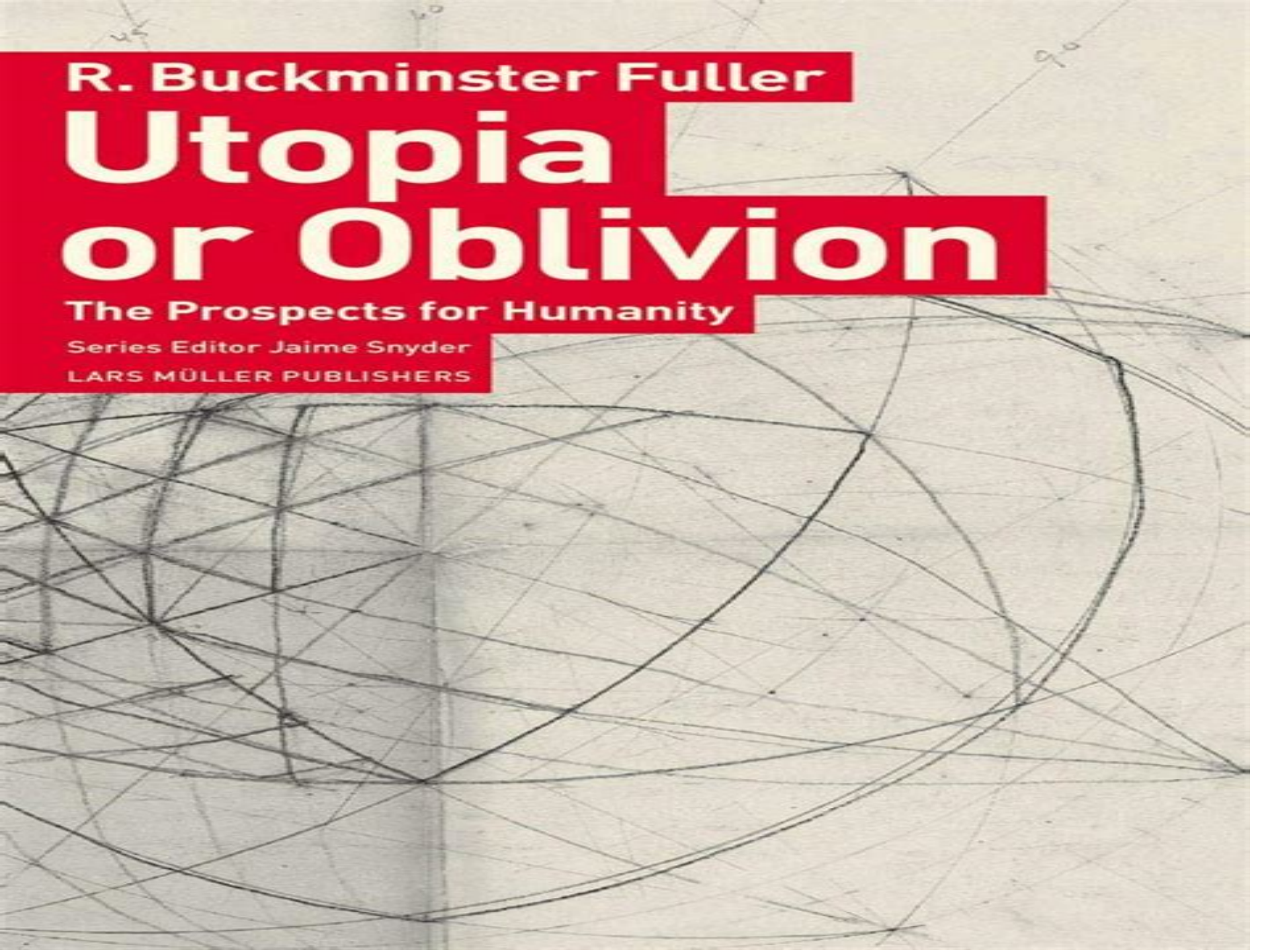

Sifting the Trash Alice Twemlow, 2017-06-09 How product design criticism has rescued some products from the trash and consigned others to the landfill Product design criticism operates at the very brink of the landfill site salvaging some products with praise but consigning others to its depths through condemnation or indifference When a designed product's usefulness is past the public happily discards it to make room for the next new thing Criticism rarely deals with how a product might be used or not used over time it is more likely to play the enabler encouraging our addiction to consumption With *Sifting the Trash* Alice Twemlow offers an especially timely reexamination of the history of product design criticism through the metaphors and actualities of the product as imminent junk and the consumer as junkie Twemlow explores five key moments over the past sixty years of product design criticism From the mid 1950s through the 1960s for example critics including Reyner Banham Deborah Allen and Richard Hamilton wrote about the ways people actually used design and invented a new kind of criticism At the 1970 International Design Conference in Aspen environmental activists protested the design establishment's lack of political engagement In the 1980s left leaning cultural critics introduced ideology to British design criticism In the 1990s dueling London exhibits offered alternative views of contemporary design And in the early 2000s professional critics were challenged by energetic design bloggers Through the years Twemlow shows critics either sifted the trash and assigned value or attempted to detect diagnose and treat the sickness of a consumer society

The Good, the Bad and the Ugly (Routledge Revivals) Rod

Hackney,2014-06-05 First published in 1990 this title presents the personal reflections of renowned community architect Rod Hackney who served for many years as President of both the Royal Institute of British Architects and the International Union of Architects Educated in the Modernist tradition of architecture in Britain and Denmark Hackney's return to England in the 1970s changed his outlook completely Cities like Birmingham and Sheffield had been ruined by ill conceived planning whole communities had been torn apart by massive destruction of Victorian terraces and relocated to grim tower block estates To those communities that he has rescued from the threat of redevelopment Rod Hackney is a local hero Determined to save Britain's inner cities he has been a major influence on Prince Charles and a powerful spokesman for the silent majority of the urban poor who often have no say as to where and how they live

French American interrelationships in the areas of design and creative thinking have been under acknowledged It is normally asserted that French architects looked to North America for technical lessons in the development of modern architecture in the 1960s but that the French cultural environment was generally hostile to American ideas This book includes interviews with French architects who visited the United States in the 1960s 1970s and then assumed influential positions in the press and education in France Some of these architects found in non mainstream America and its radical groups of architectural drop outs a liberating force free of the taint of American capitalism and the high investment technology Often living in alternative student communities they saw highly innovative low cost technical and structural systems placed in the service of collective forms of living which represented a critique not only of professional architectural practice but also of bourgeois forms of living Many of them also studied in American schools of architecture and came in contact with an intellectual and interdisciplinary style of architectural education unavailable in France at that time

Longing for the Bomb Lindsey A.
