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LEVELS OF CULTURE

- **National culture** refers to those beliefs, learned behavior patterns, values, and institutions that are shared by citizens of the same nation.
- **International culture** is the term for cultural traditions that extend beyond and across national boundaries. Because culture is transmitted through learning rather than genetically, cultural traits can spread through borrowing or *diffusion from one group to another*:
 - Borrowing
 - Colonialism
