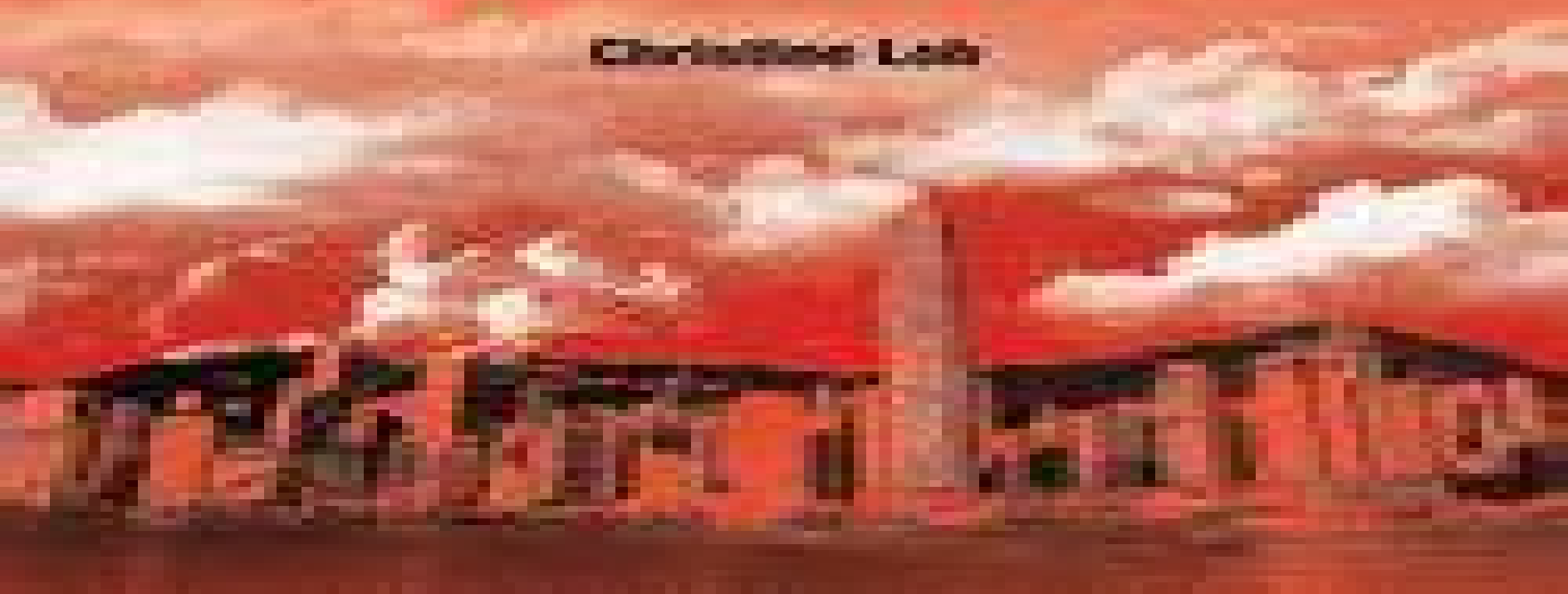

The second edition goes into greater depth on the party's view on one country two systems, patriotism and elections. The introduction has been extensively revised and the concluding chapter has been completely rewritten in order to give a thorough account of the post 1997 governance and political system in Hong Kong and where challenges lie. Christine Loh endeavours to keep the data and the materials up to date and to include the discussion of some recent events in Hong Kong. The appendices on the key targets of the party's united front activities also make the book an especially useful read for all who are interested in Hong Kong history and politics and the history of modern China. Although the author calls herself an outsider, this book provides such a distinctly incisive analysis that even an insider will pale by comparison. Hong Kong's Governance Under Chinese Sovereignty Brian C. H. Fong,2014-09-04 As a hybrid regime Hong Kong has been governed by a state business alliance since the colonial era However since the handover in 1997 the transformation of Hong Kong s political and socio economic environment has eroded the conditions that supported a viable state business alliance This state business alliance which was once a solution for Hong Kong s governance has now become a political burden rather than a political asset to the post colonial Hong Kong state This book presents a critical re examination of the post 1997 governance crisis in Hong Kong under the Tung Chee hwa and Donald Tsang administrations It shows that the state business alliance has failed to function as an organizational machinery for supporting the post colonial state and has also served to generate new governance problems Drawing upon contemporary theories on hybrid regimes and state capacity this book looks beyond the existing opposition centered explanations of Hong Kong s governance crisis By establishing the causal relationship between the failure of the state business alliance and the governance crisis facing the post colonial state Brian C H Fong broadens our understanding of the governance problems and political confrontations in post colonial Hong Kong In turn he posits that although the state business alliance worked effectively for the colonial state in the past it is now a major problem for the post colonial state and suggests that Hong Kong needs a realignment of a new governing coalition Hong Kong s Governance under Chinese Sovereignty will enrich and broaden the existing literature on Hong Kong s public governance whilst casting new light on the territory s political developments As such it will be welcomed by students and scholars interested in Chinese politics Hong Kong politics and governance

B. E. Price, 2019-01-04 The history of colonial East Asia is a human anatomy describing beneficial organs of foreign rule Proclaiming itself a schematic diagram open to inspection the anatomy of the late British Empire nevertheless obscured much more than it revealed This analogy in Price s provocative Cold War history is not presented only as an insight on imperialism but deciphers competing nationalist ideologies too The Kuomintang contended vigorously against communist rule in southern China for a decade after the end of the civil war in 1949 and Chinese communists disparaged British colonialism in Hong Kong in a war of words peaking in 1956 1957 These clashes of will did not produce new rulers in either place They informed a period of Sino British strategic partnership based on recognition that a capitalist enclave in southern China had its uses By focusing on the Hong Kong region *Resistance in Colonial and Communist China* compares anatomies of the British colonial government the Chinese communists and stateless members of the remnant Kuomintang 1950 1963 Price asserts that after 1949 the colonial government of Hong Kong politically favoured the Kuomintang organised crime societies over their communist nationalist adversaries despite historiographical explanation that it favoured neither This book challenges traditional concepts of the British colonial government and its attitude towards communist China It engages in current debates surrounding Britain s past by presenting a particularly devious episode of late colonial history *European Yearbook of Constitutional Law 2020* Ernst Hirsch Ballin, Gerhard van der Schyff, Maarten Stremmer, Maartje De Visser, 2021-03-27 The *European Yearbook of Constitutional Law* EYCL is an annual publication devoted to the study of constitutional law It aims to provide a forum for in depth analysis and discussion of new developments in the field both in Europe and beyond This second volume examines the constitutional positioning of cities across space and time Unrelenting urbanisation means that most people are or soon will be living in cities and that city administrations become in many respects their quintessential governing units Cities are places where State power is operationalised and concretised where laws and government policies transform from parchment objectives to practical realities In a similar vein cities are also places for the realisation of the constitutional rights and liberties enjoyed by individuals The book is organised around three sets of relations that await further unpacking in theory as well as practice that between cities and other institutions in the national constitutional architecture that between cities and their inhabitants and that between cities and international organisations The contributions to this book show the marked diversity in the role and powers available to cities in Europe
