Architect of Genocide: Himmler and the Final Solution Richard Breitman, 2022-09-05 A historian's carefully researched

work based on a vast array of sources documenting Hitler's and Himmler's responsibility for the murder of European Jewry. The book details the planning and the improvisations but emphasizes the former and Himmler's fanatical hatred of the Jewish race as the determinative cause of the Holocaust. Dealing with a charged controversy, Breitman makes a powerful case that by March 1941 the Final Solution was just a matter of time and timing, i.e. that the Holocaust was not a reflex of Hitler's fear that the war in Russia could not be won. Breitman argues that the Wannsee Conference merely ratified the plans and instructed other agencies to cooperate. Breitman records the instances of resistance or opposition but notes that, of course, the cooperation of thousands, many still alive and never tried, and the complicity or silence of millions were needed to carry out the murder. The book concludes that Himmler's brutality was more learned than instinctive or emotional, a methodical murderer impelled by racist dogma.

Less Than Slaves: Jewish Forced Labor and the Quest for Compensation Benjamin B. Ferencz, 2022-06-03

This 2002 reprint of Benjamin B. Ferencz's 1979 book on Jewish forced labor under the Third Reich and the attempt by various Jewish organizations to win compensation for former slave laborers from private corporations in West Germany after the war is very welcome. This book tells two related stories as the subtitle indicates. The first is the story of the use of slave labor by German industry during the Third Reich. The second is the story of the dedicated individuals, many of them Jewish lawyers, most of them working for the various interrelated Jewish agencies created to administer the German government's compensation to Jewish victims of the Holocaust to win compensation from these firms. This book is as much a memoir as it is a history. It is a story told very much from the perspective of a participant. For Ferencz was the guiding light behind the efforts to win compensation. Constructed as a series of case studies, the book tells the story of five major firms or conglomerates: I.G. Farben, Krupp, the electric companies AEG, Telefunken and Siemens, Rheinmetall, Berlin A.G. and the Flick concern, and a number of smaller concerns. In each of his case studies, Ferencz intertwines the history of the firm's use of slave labor with that of the efforts by survivor organizations and individual survivors to win compensation after the war. All in all, this book tells the story of great courage and determination by survivors and their allies to try to compel German companies to make at least partial amends for the use of

Multicultural Review **Justice Not Vengeance: Recollections** Simon Wiesenthal, 2024-09-05 The beloved and reviled Nazi hunter pens his life story and a riveting one it is Born in Galicia one of the most war ravaged territories in the world he miraculously survived World War II with more than one hair's breadth escape Since that time he has been occupied mainly with tracking down Nazi war criminals who have gone into hiding and in pushing through publicity reluctant German and Austrian officials to bring war criminals to justice the book consists of mainly a miscellany of cases and questions that have engaged the 81 year old Mr Wiesenthal who has lived in Vienna since the war through the course of his unique career Above all it contains the story of how after 12 years of tracking him down he was able to point his finger at Adolf Eichmann then living pseudonymously in Argentina so that the Israelis could kidnap him for trial and eventual execution But apart from successes such as this one Mr Wiesenthal's book contains histories of Nazi war criminals whose whereabouts have not yet been discovered or who have remained unattainable in spite of his efforts this book may best be described as a companion volume or even as a supplement to Mr Wiesenthal's classic 1967 work *The Murderers Among Us* Mr Wiesenthal's recollections do not involve evil men alone There is a chapter on the late Andrei Sakharov praising him and describing the author's efforts on his behalf and there is one on Raoul Wallenberg who was arrested by the victorious Soviets in February 1945 after his heroic efforts the previous year had succeeded in saving the lives of tens of thousands of Jews in Budapest Since then Mr Wallenberg's whereabouts have remained a mystery In all this book provides a sense of a formidable presence of a force larger than life that seems equal to an enormous task it has taken on The New York Times Simon Wiesenthal who has devoted his life to hunting down Nazis believes that guilt cannot be forgiven but only paid for by expiation In his memoirs which created a furor when they were published in Austria where he now lives in 1988 Wiesenthal explores the lack of remorse among former Austrian Nazis in the larger context of that country's approach to its past This is not an autobiography in the strict sense those wishing a fuller account of his life should turn to *The Murderers Among Us* 1967 rather Wiesenthal shows here how his own pursuit of war criminals came to be entangled in the net of Austrian politics Appropriately *Justice Not Vengeance* reaches its climax in a narrative of his battles with the late Austrian chancellor Bruno Kreisky In these absorbing memoirs Wiesenthal goes some way toward counting up the cost to Austria itself of its ongoing destructive attempt to suppress and to deny its past *Commentary Magazine* The Nazi hunter's life and *raison d'être* are eloquently encapsulated by this autobiography and its title The book opens with a biographical sketch by Peter Lingens an Austrian journalist who provides background on Wiesenthal's life up until the sleuth's second escape from death shortly

Trujillo: The Life and Times of a Caribbean Dictator Robert D. Crassweller, 2023-01-28 This is the most satisfactory study of Rafael Trujillo 1891 1961 yet published Mr Crassweller has used printed materials and interviews to reconstruct the life of the Caribbean strongman and his book is not the typical sycophantic panegyric published during Trujillo s rule or a recapitulation of the worst excesses of his dictatorship It is a surprisingly well balanced attempt to understand the man his motives and his regime Trujillo was the product of the United States occupation between 1916 and 1924 Born in humble circumstances in 1891 his career had been inauspicious until he discovered that he might be able to obtain a commission in a new constabulary being formed by the occupation forces within ten years he was in charge of the nation s armed forces and by 1930 he was President From that time until his death he ruled his country with an iron hand and the author lucidly shows how he converted it into his own personal estate through political and economic manipulation A vain man Trujillo used the vanity of others to achieve his goals He thought everyone had his price and all too often he was
