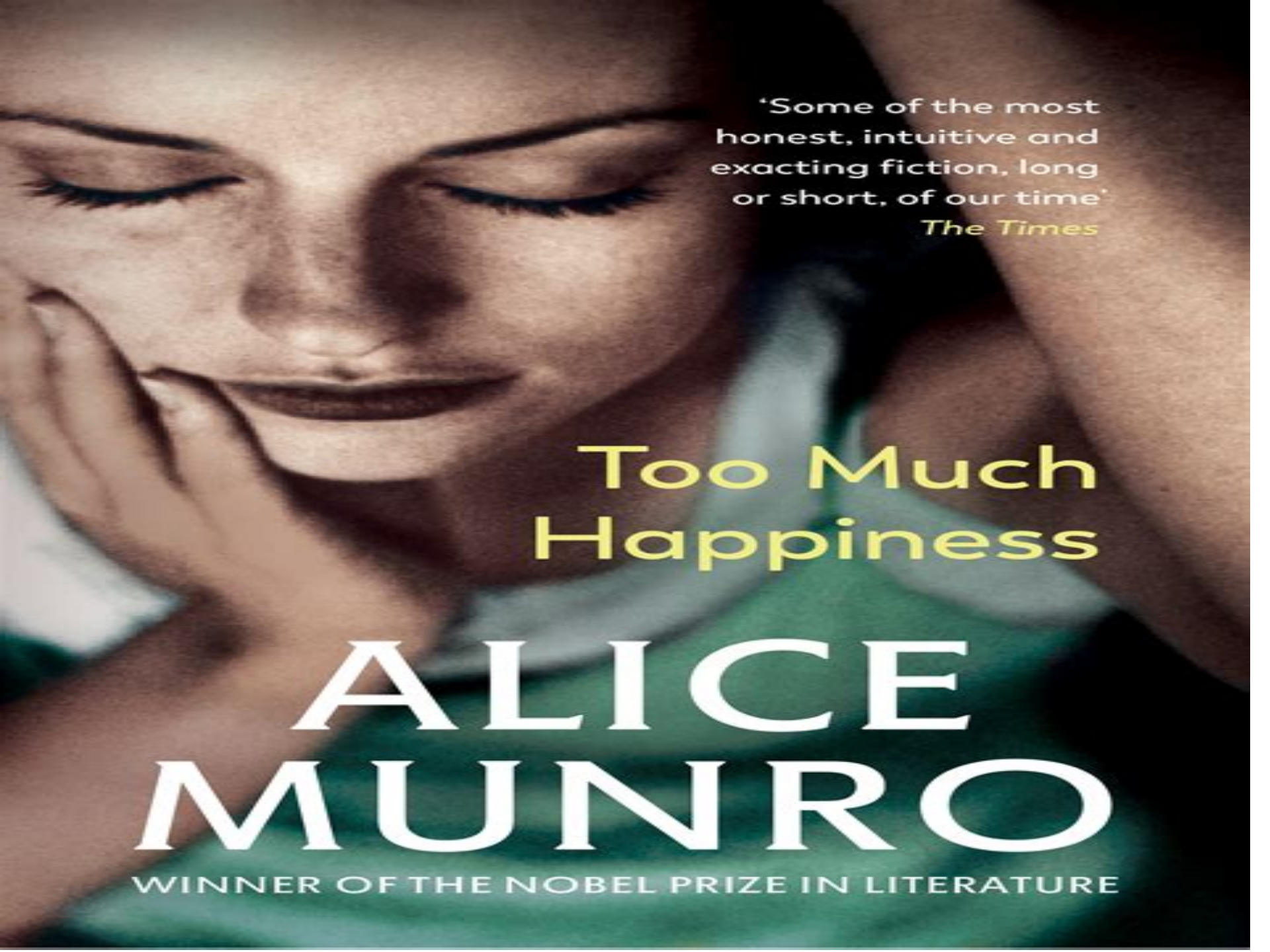

Too Much Happiness Alice Munro, 2010-09 It presents stories about Svengali men and radical women who outmanoeuvre them about destructive marriages and curdled friendships about mothers and sons about moments which change or haunt a life A wife and mother whose spirit has been crushed finds release from her extraordinary pain in the most unlikely place The young victim of a humiliating seduction finds an unusual way to get her own back and move on An older woman dying of cancer weaves a poisonous story to save her life The long title story follows Sophia Kovalevsky a late nineteenth century Russian emigree and mathematical genius as she takes a fateful winter journey that begins with a visit to her lover on the Riviera and ends in Sweden where she is a professor at the only university willing to hire a woman to teach her subject
