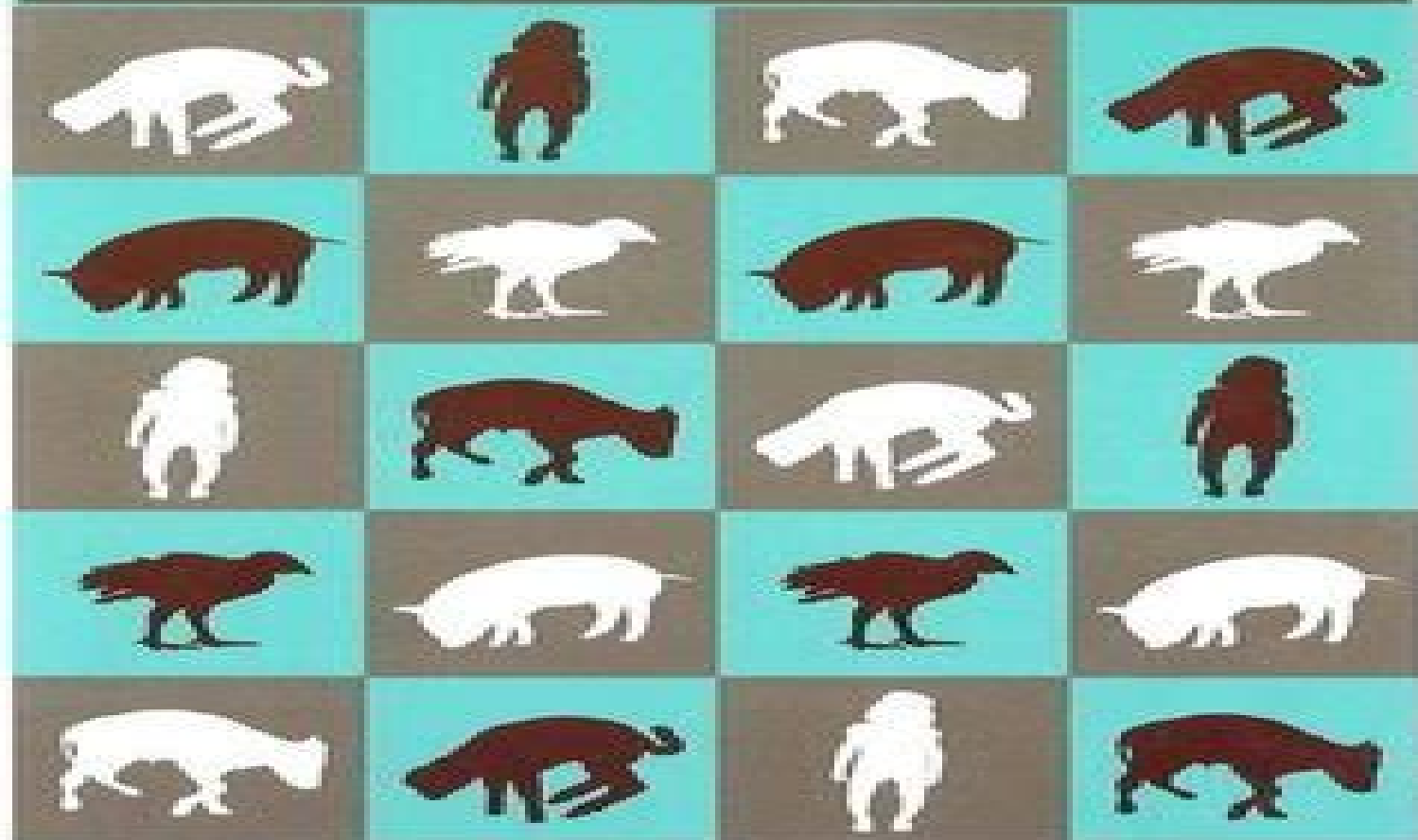

It usually refers to the food-derived products which may sell in medicinal form, possessing physiological benefits to the host while promoting health and wellness and providing protection against chronic disorders. They may also increase the life expectancy, delay the aging and/or support the structure and function of the body organs. Demand for nutraceuticals with potential to prevent and treat chronic disorders has been interestingly increasing over the past few years.
