Walls Built On Sand Anh Nga Longva, 2019-05-20 When Iraq invaded Kuwait in 1990 the sight of tens of thousands of non Kuwaiti Arabs Indians East Asians and Westerners fleeing or trapped under occupation made the outside world suddenly aware of a singular fact of Kuwaiti society that Kuwaitis are an absolute minority in their own country Basing her analysis on extensive fieldwork and archiv Arab Migrant Communities in the GCC Zahra Babar, 2017 This volume provides a series of empirically dense analyses of the historical and contemporary dynamics of Arab intra regional migration to the monarchies of the Persian Gulf and unravels the ways in which particular social and cultural practices of Arab migrants interact with the host states Among other things specific contributions allow us to consider the socioeconomic and political factors that have historically shaped the character of the Arab migratory experience the sorts of work opportunities that Arab migrants have sought in the region what their work conditions and lived experiences have been and whether we are able to discern any patterns of sociocultural integration for Arab non nationals Asianization of Migrant Workers in the Gulf Countries S. Marx in the Field Alessandra Mezzadri, 2021-02-15 Marx in the Field is a unique edited collection illustrating the relevance of the Marxian method to study contemporary capitalism and the global development process Essays in the collection bring Marx to the field in three ways They illustrate how Marxian categories can be concretely deployed for field research in the global economy they analyse how these categories may be adapted during fieldwork and they discuss data collection methods supporting Marxian analysis Crucially many of the contributions expand the scope of Marxian analysis by combining its insights with those of other intellectual traditions including radical feminisms critical realism and postcolonial studies The book defines the possibilities and challenges of fieldwork guided by Marxian analysis including those emerging from the COVID 19 pandemic The collection takes a global approach to the study of development and of contemporary capitalism While some essays focus on themes and geographical areas of long term concern for international development like informal or rural poverty and work across South Asia Southern and West Africa or South America others focus instead on actors benefitting from the development process like regional exporters larger farmers and traders or on unequal socio economic outcomes across richer and emerging economies and regions including Gulf countries North America Southern Europe or Post Soviet Central and Eastern Europe Some essays explore global processes cutting across the world economy connecting multiple regions actors and inequalities While some of the contributions focus on classic Marxian tropes in the study of contemporary capitalism like class labour and working conditions agrarian change or global commodity chains and prices others aim at demonstrating the relevance of the Marxian method beyond its traditional boundaries for instance for exploring the interplays between food nutrition and poverty the links between social reproduction gender and homework the features of migration and refugees regimes tribal chieftaincy structures or prison labour or the dynamics structuring global surrogacy Overall through the analysis of an extremely varied set of concrete settings and cases this book illustrates the extraordinary insights we can gain by bringing Marx in the field

Life on the Outside Oivind Fuglerud, 1999-02-20 This study of the Tamil diaspora is one of the first full ethnographic studies of a postcolonial migrant community and a major contribution to the study of migration globalisation identity politics and long distance nationalism from an anthropological perspective Fuglerud s study traces the history of Tamil migration from the arrival of the economic migrants of the 1960s to the asylum seekers of the mid 1980s onwards He draws unnerving parallels between the status of the Tamil community in Sri Lanka as a beleaguered and persecuted minority waging a war of liberation and as a displaced marginalised and excluded refugee community Fuglerud argues that in the process of displacement particular aspects of Tamil culture marriage dowry chastity and ritual acquire a heightened significance He examines the contradictions and inconsistencies which characterise the Tamil refugee communities and the success of

revolutionary Tamil nationalism in exile highlighting the transnational nature of identity politics

Beyond Exception Ahmed Kanna, Amélie Le Renard, Neha Vora, 2020-08-15 Over the nearly two decades that they have each been conducting fieldwork in the Arabian Peninsula Ahmed Kanna Amélie Le Renard and Neha Vora have regularly encountered exoticizing and exceptionalist discourses about the region and its people political systems and prevalent cultural practices These persistent encounters became the springboard for this book a reflection on conducting fieldwork within a field that is marked by such representations The three focus on deconstructing the exceptionalist representations that circulate about the Arabian Peninsula They analyze what exceptionalism does how it is used by various people and how it helps shape power relations in the societies they study They propose ways that this analysis of exceptionalism provides tools for rethinking the concepts that have become commonplace structuring narratives and analytical frameworks within fieldwork in and on the Arabian Peninsula They ask What would not only Middle East studies but studies of postcolonial societies and global capitalism in other parts of the world look like if the Arabian Peninsula was central rather than peripheral or exceptional to ongoing sociohistorical processes and representational practices The authors explore how the exceptionalizing discourses that permeate Arabian Peninsula studies spring from colonialist discourses still operative in anthropology and sociology more generally and suggest that de exceptionalizing the region within their disciplines can offer opportunities for decolonized knowledge production

The Immigrant Other Rich Furman, Greg Lamphear, Douglas Epps, 2016-03-01 The immigrants profiled in *The Immigrant Other* shed light on a system designed to dehumanize and disenfranchise them and they describe the difficulty of finding shelter in an increasingly globalized and unsympathetic world They include Muslims facing discrimination from both the War on Terror and the War on Immigration Latino day laborers Filipino immigrants supporting themselves and their families back home and Brazilian parents terrified of being separated from their naturalized children Immigrants living in Spain Australia Greece and Qatar are also represented showcasing the similarities and differences in the treatment of immigrants worldwide Each chapter in this anthology pairs a description of specific state national and transnational immigration laws and regulations with the testimony of individuals struggling to find legitimacy and sanctuary among them

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
