Williams's own wife fell under the tomahawk or war club. Survivors of the march willed themselves to live and endured captivity. Ransomed by the royal governor of Massachusetts, the captives later returned home to Deerfield, rebuilt their town, and for the rest of their lives told the incredible tale. The memoir of Rev. Williams, *The Redeemed Captive*, published soon after his liberation, became one of the first bestselling books in American history and remains a literary classic. *The Old Indian Door* is a touchstone that conjures up one of the most dramatic and inspiring stories of colonial America.
