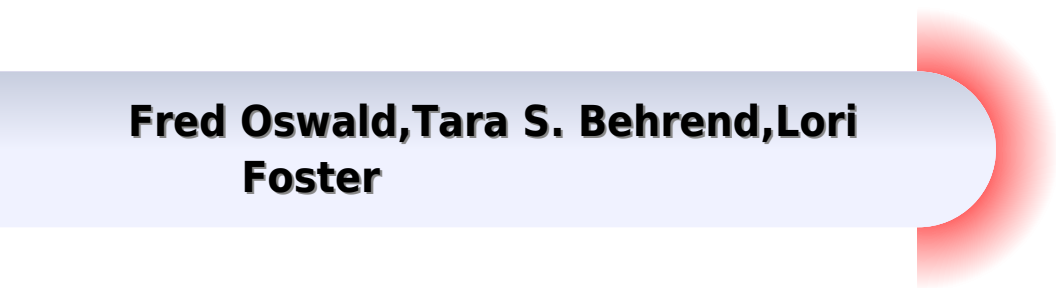

## **Working And Poor How Economic And Policy Changes Are Affecting Low Wage Workers:**

**Working and Poor** Rebecca M. Blank, Sheldon Danziger, Robert F. Schoeni, 2007-01-09 Over the last three decades large scale economic developments such as technological change the decline in unionization and changing skill requirements have exacted their biggest toll on low wage workers These workers often possess few marketable skills and few resources with which to support themselves during periods of economic transition In *Working and Poor* a distinguished group of economists and policy experts headlined by editors Rebecca Blank Sheldon Danziger and Robert Schoeni examine how economic and policy changes over the last twenty five years have affected the well being of low wage workers and their families *Working and Poor* examines every facet of the economic well being of less skilled workers from employment and earnings opportunities to consumption behavior and social assistance policies Rebecca Blank and Heidi Schierholz document the different trends in work and wages among less skilled women and men Between 1979 and 2003 labor force participation rose rapidly for these women along with more modest increases in wages while among the men both employment and wages fell David Card and John DiNardo review the evidence on how technological changes have affected less skilled workers and conclude that the effect has been smaller than many observers claim Philip Levine examines the effectiveness of the Unemployment Insurance program during recessions He finds that the program s eligibility rules which deny benefits to workers who have not met minimum earnings requirements exclude the very people who require help most and should be adjusted to provide for those with the highest need On the other hand Therese J McGuire and David F Merriman show that government help remains a valuable source of support during economic downturns They find that during the most recent recession in 2001 when state budgets were stretched thin legislatures resisted political pressure to cut spending for the poor *Working and Poor* provides a valuable analysis of the role that public policy changes can play in improving the plight of the working poor A comprehensive analysis of trends over the last twenty five years this book provides an invaluable reference for the public discussion of work and poverty in America A Volume in the National Poverty Center Series on Poverty and Public Policy

*Changing Poverty, Changing Policies* Maria Cancian, Sheldon Danziger, 2009-08-27 Poverty declined significantly in the decade after Lyndon Johnson s 1964 declaration of War on Poverty Dramatically increased federal funding for education and training programs social security benefits other income support programs and a growing economy reduced poverty and raised expectations that income poverty could be eliminated within a generation Yet the official poverty rate has never fallen below its 1973 level and remains higher than the rates in many other advanced economies In this book editors Maria Cancian and Sheldon Danziger and leading poverty researchers assess why the War on Poverty was not won and analyze the most promising strategies to reduce poverty in the twenty first century economy *Changing Poverty Changing Policies* documents how economic social demographic and public policy changes since the early 1970s have altered who is poor and where antipoverty initiatives have kept pace or fallen behind Part I shows that little progress has been made in

reducing poverty except among the elderly in the last three decades The chapters examine how changing labor market opportunities for less educated workers have increased their risk of poverty Rebecca Blank and how family structure changes Maria Cancian and Deborah Reed and immigration have affected poverty Steven Raphael and Eugene Smolensky Part II assesses the ways childhood poverty influences adult outcomes Markus J ntti finds that poor American children are more likely to be poor adults than are children in many other industrialized countries Part III focuses on current antipoverty policies and possible alternatives Jane Waldfogel demonstrates that policies in other countries such as sick leave subsidized child care and schedule flexibility help low wage parents better balance work and family responsibilities Part IV considers how rethinking and redefining poverty might take antipoverty policies in new directions Mary Jo Bane assesses the politics of poverty since the 1996 welfare reform act Robert Haveman argues that income based poverty measures should be expanded as they have been in Europe to include social exclusion and multiple dimensions of material hardships Changing Poverty Changing Policies shows that thoughtful policy reforms can reduce poverty and promote opportunities for poor workers and their families The authors focus on pragmatic measures that have real possibilities of being implemented in the United States not only provides vital knowledge about what works but real hope for change *Strategies for Improving Economic Mobility of Workers* Maude Toussaint-Comeau, Bruce D. Meyer, 2009 The chapters in this book aim at offering a fresh review of the economic circumstances of disadvantaged segments of our Population as well as providing a provocative but nuanced assessment of the effectiveness of various policies and practices geared to redress a number of issues affecting them Examples of programs discussed include housing allowances that address the spatial mismatch between poor inner city neighborhoods and areas with job growth education retention programs and financial aid for older low income students employment and training programs for former welfare recipients and labor market reentry programs for the hard to employ ex offenders in distressed communities This diversity of programs reflects the variety of challenges and varying issues that vulnerable populations and communities confront it also reflects the many creative ways of approaching these problems

Bailey, Sheldon Danziger, 2013-07-31 Many believe that the War on Poverty launched by President Johnson in 1964 ended in failure In 2010 the official poverty rate was 15 percent almost as high as when the War on Poverty was declared Historical and contemporary accounts often portray the War on Poverty as a costly experiment that created doubts about the ability of public policies to address complex social problems *Legacies of the War on Poverty* drawing from fifty years of empirical evidence documents that this popular view is too negative The volume offers a balanced assessment of the War on Poverty that highlights some remarkable policy successes and promises to shift the national conversation on poverty in America Featuring contributions from leading poverty researchers *Legacies of the War on Poverty* demonstrates that poverty and racial discrimination would likely have been much greater today if the War on Poverty had not been launched Chloe Gibbs Jens Ludwig and Douglas Miller dispel the notion that the Head Start education program does not work While its impact on

children's test scores fade the program contributes to participants long term educational achievement and importantly their earnings growth later in life Elizabeth Cascio and Sarah Reber show that Title I legislation reduced the school funding gap between poorer and richer states and prompted Southern school districts to desegregate increasing educational opportunity for African Americans The volume also examines the significant consequences of income support housing and health care programs Jane Waldfogel shows that without the era's expansion of food stamps and other nutrition programs the child poverty rate in 2010 would have been three percentage points higher Kathleen McGarry examines the policies that contributed to a great success of the War on Poverty the rapid decline in elderly poverty which fell from 35 percent in 1959 to below 10 percent in 2010 Barbara Wolfe concludes that Medicaid and Community Health Centers contributed to large reductions in infant mortality and increased life expectancy Katherine Swartz finds that Medicare and Medicaid increased access to health care among the elderly and reduced the risk that they could not afford care or that obtaining it would bankrupt them and their families Legacies of the War on Poverty demonstrates that well designed government programs can reduce poverty racial discrimination and material hardships This insightful volume refutes pessimism about the effects of social policies and provides new lessons about what more can be done to improve the lives of the poor

**Diversity and Disparities** John Logan, 2014-11-01 The United States is more diverse than ever before Increased immigration has added to a vibrant cultural fabric and women and minorities have made significant strides in overcoming overt discrimination At the same time economic inequality has increased significantly in recent decades and the Great Recession substantially weakened the economic standing not only of the poor but also of the middle class Diversity and Disparities edited by sociologist John Logan assembles impressive new studies that interpret the social and economic changes in the United States over the last

decade The authors leading social scientists from many disciplines analyze changes in the labor market family structure immigration and race They find that while America has grown more diverse the opportunities available to disadvantaged groups have become more unequal Drawing on detailed data from the decennial census the American Community Survey and other sources the authors chart the growing diversity and the deepening disparities among different groups in the United States Harry J Holzer and Marek Hlavac document that although the economy always rises and falls over the business cycle the Great Recession of 2007 2009 was a catastrophic event that saw record levels of unemployment especially among less educated workers young people and minorities Emily Rosenbaum shows how the Great Recession amplified disparities in access to home ownership and demonstrates that young adults especially African Americans are falling behind previous cohorts not only in home ownership and wealth but even in starting their own families and households Sean F Reardon and Kendra Bischoff explore the rise of class segregation as higher income Americans are moving away from others into separate and privileged neighborhoods and communities Immigration has also seen class polarization with an increase in both highly skilled workers and undocumented immigrants As Frank D Bean and his colleagues show the lack of a path to legal status for undocumented immigrants inhibits the educational and economic opportunities for their children and grandchildren Barrett Lee and colleagues demonstrate that the nation and most cities and towns are becoming more diverse by race and ethnicity However while black white segregation is slowly falling Hispanics and Asians remain as segregated today as they were in 1980 Diversity and Disparities raises concerns about the extent of socioeconomic immobility in the United States today This volume provides valuable information for policymakers journalists and researchers seeking to understand the current state of the nation

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
