insights and does give access to worlds that are new and often surprising and unconventional

Women and Militant Wars Swati Parashar, 2014-03-05 This book explores women's militant activities in insurgent wars and seeks to understand what women do in wars. In International Relations, inter-state conflict, anti-state armed insurgency, and armed militancy are essentially seen as wars where collective violence against civilians and security forces is used to achieve political objectives. Extending the notion of war as politics of injury to the armed militancy in Indian administered Kashmir and the Tamil armed insurgency in Sri Lanka, this book explores how women participate in militant wars and how that politics not only shapes the gendered understandings of women's identities and bodies but is in turn shaped by them. The case studies discussed in the book offer new comparative insight into two different and most prevalent forms of insurgent wars today: religious, political, and ethno-nationalist. Empirical analyses of women's roles in the Sri Lankan Tamil militant group, the LTTE, and the logistical/ideological support women provide to militant groups active in Indian administered Kashmir suggest that these insurgent wars have their own gender dynamics in recruitment and operational strategies. Thus, *Women and Militant Wars* provides an excellent insight into the gender politics of these insurgencies and women's roles and experiences within them. This book will be of much interest to students and scholars of critical war and security studies, feminist international relations, gender studies, terrorism, and political violence, South Asia studies, and IR in general.

The reality of women's conflict-driven migration, however, falls between these two axes. The contributors use a variety of research methods including ethnography, dialogue, oral history, textual analyses, and consciousness-raising techniques.

The process of migration is not just a phase but leads on to a series of adjustments, including acculturation, which may occur across generations. Factors such as changes in diet, attitudes, and beliefs, and overall adjustment are important in settling down and making the individuals feel secure. This period of adjustment will depend upon the individual migrant's pre-migration experiences, migration process, and post-migration experiences but also upon an individual's personality, social support, and emotional response to migration. Socio-demographic factors such as age, gender, educational, and economic status will all play a role in post-migration adjustment. In order to understand the impact on individuals, not only the type of migration and different stressors but also the types of psychological mechanisms at a personal level and the resources and
