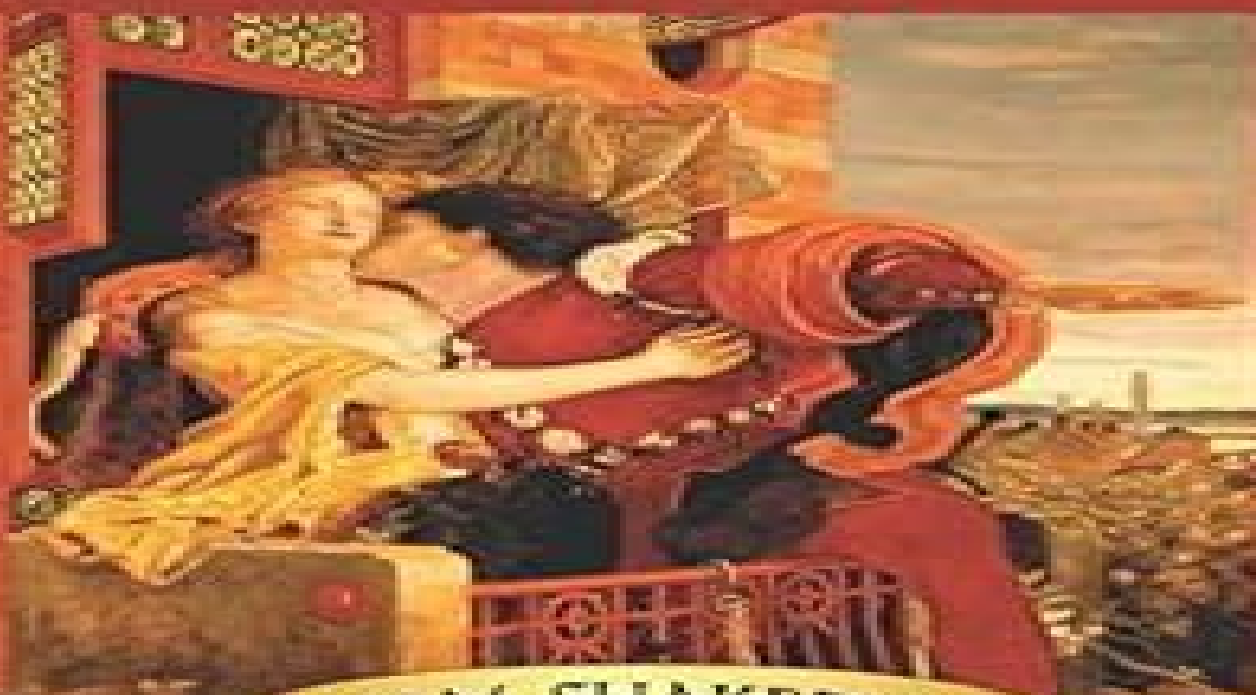

Romeo and Juliet Annotated Tragic Dramas and Plays William Shakespeare, 2020-03-27 William Shakespeare baptised 26 April 1564 died 23 April 1616 was an English poet and playwright widely regarded as the greatest writer in the English language and the world's pre-eminent dramatist He is often called England's national poet and the Bard of Avon or simply The Bard His surviving works consist of 38 plays 154 sonnets two long narrative poems and several other poems His plays have been translated into every major living language and are performed more often than those of any other playwright Shakespeare was born and raised in Stratford-upon-Avon At the age of 18 he married Anne Hathaway who bore him three children Susanna and twins Hamnet and Judith Between 1585 and 1592 he began a successful career in London as an actor, writer and part owner of the playing company the Lord Chamberlain's Men later known as the King's Men He appears to have retired to Stratford around 1613 where he died three years later Few records of Shakespeare's private life survive and there has been considerable speculation about such matters as his sexuality, religious beliefs and whether the works attributed to him were written by others Shakespeare produced most of his known work between 1590 and 1613 His early plays were mainly comedies and histories genres he raised to the peak of sophistication and artistry by the end of the sixteenth century Next he wrote mainly tragedies until about 1608 including Hamlet, King Lear and Macbeth considered some of the finest examples in the English language In his last phase he wrote tragicomedies also known as romances and collaborated with other playwrights Many of his plays were published in editions of varying quality and accuracy during his lifetime and in 1623 two of his former theatrical colleagues published the First Folio a collected edition of his dramatic works that included all but two of the plays now recognised as Shakespeare's Shakespeare was a respected poet and playwright in his own day but his reputation did not rise to its present heights until the nineteenth century The Romantics in particular acclaimed Shakespeare's genius and the Victorians hero-worshipped Shakespeare with a reverence that George Bernard Shaw called bardolatry In the twentieth century his work was repeatedly adopted and rediscovered by new movements in scholarship and performance His plays remain highly popular today and are consistently performed and reinterpreted in diverse cultural and political contexts throughout the world

William Painter in 1567 Shakespeare borrowed heavily from both but expanded the plot by developing a number of supporting characters particularly Mercutio and Paris Believed to have been written between 1591 and 1595 the play was first published in a quarto version in 1597 The text of the first quarto version was of poor quality however and later editions corrected the text to conform more closely with Shakespeare s original Shakespeare s use of his poetic dramatic structure especially effects such as switching between comedy and tragedy to heighten tension his expansion of minor characters and his use of sub plots to embellish the story has been praised as an early sign of his dramatic skill The play ascribes different poetic forms to different characters sometimes changing the form as the character develops Romeo for example grows more adept at the sonnet over the course of the play Romeo and Juliet has been adapted numerous times for stage film musical and opera venues During the English Restoration it was revived and heavily revised by William Davenant David Garrick s 18th century version also modified several scenes removing material then considered indecent and Georg Benda s Romeo und Julie omitted much of the action and added a happy ending Performances in the 19th century including Charlotte Cushman s restored the original text and focused on greater realism John Gielgud s 1935 version kept very close to Shakespeare s text and used Elizabethan costumes and staging to enhance the drama In the 20th and into the 21st century the play has been adapted in versions as diverse as George Cukor s 1935 film Romeo and Juliet Franco Zeffirelli s 1968 version Romeo and Juliet and Baz Luhrmann s 1996 MTV inspired Romeo Juliet

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
