James Gregor, 2017-07-05 China has always been something of a mystery to Westerners For one generation Mao Zedong and his followers were simple agrarian reformers while for another they were the communist emperor and his blue ants In the 1970s some of the finest Sinologists believed there was much the United States could learn from Mao s Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution with regard to bureaucracy criminal justice health care and mass education By the 1980s those same theorists asserted that Maoism was nothing more than a feudal fascism and had absolutely nothing positive to teach Marxism China and Development provides a plausible

explanation of these developments that have had such a powerful effect on the people of China for the past half century The author describes and explains the strange collection of beliefs that made up the Marxism of Mao Zedong He seeks to understand why the communist leadership of China like that of the USSR tried to spur economic growth by abandoning the market modalities common to developed economies A James Gregor's conceptual framework is both original and makes more comprehensible the history of Marxism and the history of China Among the major topics he covers are imperialism political democracy economics and alternatives to Maoism and Marxism for China While it is unlikely that our understanding of so complex a series of events as modern Chinese history will soon become less controversial Marxism China and Development's clear concise explanations will clarify some perplexing areas and make the new turns in Chinese political economy more understandable This is a monumental effort at theory construction that will be of interest to political scientists economists sociologists and Sinologists

The Order of Economic Liberalization Ronald I. McKinnon, 1993-10 Can knowledge of financial policies in developing countries over four decades help the socialist economies of Asia and Eastern Europe become open market economies in the 1990s In all these countries the loss of fiscal and monetary control has often resulted in high inflation that undermines the liberalization process itself In the second edition of The Order of Economic Liberalization Ronald McKinnon builds on his influential work on the liberalization of financial markets in less developed countries and outlines the progression necessary to move from a repressed to an open economy New to this edition are chapters that contrast the gradual Chinese approach to liberalizing domestic and foreign trade with the big bang approach followed by some Eastern European countries and republics of the former Soviet Union Financial control and macroeconomic stability McKinnon argues are more critical to a successful transition than is any crash program to privatize state owned industrial assets and the banking system

Money Unmade David Woodruff, 2018-05-31 Since the collapse of the Soviet Union Russians have seen the ruble steadily lose ground to alternative means of payment such as barter and privately issued quasi monies Industry now collects as much as 70 percent of its receipts in nonmonetary form leaving many firms with too little cash to pay salaries and taxes In this ground breaking book on the Russian economy David Woodruff argues that Moscow's inability to control the nation's currency is not a carry over from the Soviet past Rather the Russian government has failed to build the administrative capacity and political support demanded by monetary consolidation a neglected but crucial aspect of capitalist statebuilding Drawing on a vast array of empirical evidence Woodruff shows how the widespread use of barter arose as local authorities tried to protect industry against the destructive effects of price increases and crude tax and accounting systems As businesses fled or were driven from the money economy provincial governments invented new ways to tax in kind and issued substitutes for the ruble In turn the federal authorities unable to coerce firms either to operate in the money economy or to abandon business altogether were forced to make accommodations to barter and to ruble alternatives Woodruff describes the enormous fiscal difficulties that resulted and recounts the intense political battles over

attempts to address the problem Through an overview of monetary consolidation in other nations Woodruff demonstrates that the struggles of the new Russian state have much to teach us about the political history of money worldwide Sovereignty over money cannot he argues be imposed by government on a recalcitrant society Nor can it be assumed as a by product of disciplined policies aimed at market reform Monetary consolidation is at heart a political achievement requiring political support

Russia Since 1980 Steven Rosefielde, Stefan Hedlund, 2009 Russia since 1980 recounts the epochal political economic and social changes that destroyed the Soviet Union ushering in a perplexing new order Two decades after Mikhail Gorbachev initiated his regime wrecking radical reforms Russia has reemerged as a superpower It has survived a hyperdepression modernized restored private property and business adopted a liberal democratic persona and asserted claims to global leadership Many in the West perceive these developments as proof of a better globalized tomorrow while others foresee a new cold war Globalizers contend that Russia is speedily democratizing marketizing and humanizing creating a regime based on the rule of law and respect for civil rights Opponents counterclaim that Russia before and during the Soviet period was similarly misportrayed and insist that Medvedev s Russia is just another variation of an authoritarian Muscovite model that has prevailed for more than five centuries The cases for both positions are explored while chronicling events since 1980 and a verdict is rendered in favor of Muscovite continuity Russia will continue challenging the West until it breaks with its cultural legacy
