Sissy Insurgencies Marlon B. Ross, 2021-12-06 In *Sissy Insurgencies* Marlon B Ross focuses on the figure of the sissy in order to rethink how Americans have imagined articulated and negotiated manhood and boyhood from the 1880s to the present Rather than collapsing sissiness into homosexuality Ross shows how sissiness constitutes a historically fluid range of gender practices that are expressed as a physical manifestation discursive epithet social identity and political phenomenon He reconsiders several black leaders intellectuals musicians and athletes within the context of sissiness from Booker T Washington George Washington Carver and James Baldwin to Little Richard Amiri Baraka and Wilt Chamberlain Whether examining Washington s practice of cleaning as an iteration of sissiness Baldwin s self fashioned sissy deportment or sissiphobia in professional sports and black nationalism Ross demonstrates that sissiness can be embraced and exploited to conform to American gender norms or disrupt racialized patriarchy In this way sissiness constitutes a central element in modern understandings of race and gender

The Slow Undoing Stephen H. Lowe, 2021-06-02 A study of how South Carolina s federal district courts were central to achieving and solidifying gains during the civil rights movement As the first comprehensive study of one state s federal district courts during the long civil rights movement *The Slow Undoing* argues for a reconsideration of the role of the federal courts in the civil rights movement It places the courts as a central battleground at the intersections of struggles over race law and civil rights During the long civil rights movement Black and White South Carolinians used the courts as a venue to contest the meanings of the constitution justice equality and citizenship African American plaintiffs and lawyers from South Carolina with the support of Thurgood Marshall and other lawyers from the NAACP Legal Defense and Education Fund brought and argued civil rights lawsuits in South Carolina s federal courts attempting to secure the vote raise teacher salaries and to equalize and then desegregate schools parks and public life In response white citizens state politicians and local officials hired their own lawyers who countered these arguments by crafting new legal theories in an attempt to defend state practices and thwart African American aspirations of equality and to preserve white supremacy *The Slow Undoing* argues for a reconsideration of the role of federal courts in the

civil rights movement by demonstrating that both before and after Brown v Board of Education the federal district courts were centrally important to achieving and solidifying civil rights gains It relies on the entire legal record of actions in the federal district courts of South Carolina from 1940 to 1970 to make the case It argues that rather than relying on litigation during the pre Brown era and direct action in the post Brown era African Americans instead used courts and direct action in tandem to bring down legal segregation throughout the long civil rights era But the process was far from linear and the courts were not always a progressive force The battles were long the victories won were often imperfect and many of the fights remain Author Stephen H Lowe offers a chronicle of this enduring struggle Sexual Discretion Jeffrey Q. Justesen, 2012-07-02 Although he was one of the most important African American political leaders during the last decade of the nineteenth century George Henry White has been one of the least remembered A North Carolina representative from 1897 to 1901 White was the last man of his race to serve in the Congress during the post Reconstruction period and his departure left a void that would go unfilled for nearly thirty years At once the most acclaimed and reviled symbol of the freed slaves whose cause he heralded White remains today largely a footnote to history In this exhaustively researched biography Benjamin R Justesen rescues from obscurity the fascinating story of this compelling figure's life and accomplishments The mixed race son of a free turpentine farmer White became a teacher lawyer and prosecutor in rural North Carolina From these modest beginnings he rose in 1896 to become the only black member of the House of Representatives and perhaps the most nationally visible African American politician of his time White was outspoken in his challenge to racial injustice but as Justesen shows he was no militant racial extremist as antagonistic white democrats charged His plea was always for simple justice in a nation whose democratic principles he passionately loved A conservative by philosophy he was a dedicated Republican to the end After he retired from Congress he remained active in the fight against racial discrimination working
