Wasted Talent in "The Bluest Eye" by Toni Morrison Surinder Kaur, 2015-11-26 Scientific Essay from the year 2015 in the subject American Studies Literature language English abstract The Bluest Eye is simple yet a difficult narrative of a twelve year old black girl Pecola s desire to have blue eyes The question arises why does a black girl want blue eyes Why does she want to look differently What causes this desire in her As the story unfolds we get answers to these questions and also a realization that how the simple things like cup images or candy wrappers can be a strong factor in influencing an individual s psychological response to beauty and his her own self importance The present paper while building on existing criticism tries to explore the popular culture for instance children items cups dolls candies and movies and its individual psychological response These commercial products play a pivotal role in establishing beauty aesthetics Regular exposure to these ideals results in their idealization and a longing in people to have these defining physical features of beauty It creates an environment of superiority and inferiority People who possess the defining features physical are considered superior to those who don t have these physical features This adversely affects their psyche and becomes a reason for their downfall

Father-Daughter Incest in Twentieth-Century American Literature Christine Grogan, 2016-10-03 The first major study to challenge the narrow definition of post traumatic stress disorder PTSD by rereading six American literary texts this book argues for the importance of literature in representing not just circumscribed singular traumatic events as Cathy Caruth argued in the late nineties but for giving voice to chronic and cumulative or complex traumatic experiences This interdisciplinary study traces the development of father daughter incest narratives published in the last hundred years from male authored fiction to female authored memoir bringing new readings to Fitzgerald s Tender Is the Night Ellison s Invisible Man and the Dylan Farrow Woody Allen case This study builds on the work of those ushering in a second wave of trauma theory which has argued that the difficulty of speaking about a traumatic experience is not necessarily caused by neurobiological changes that prevent victims from recalling details Rather it s from social and political repercussions In other words they argue that many who experience trauma aren t unable to deliver accounts they fear the results There is a significant gender component to trauma whose implications along with those of race and class have largely gone unexamined in the first wave of trauma theory Exploring two additional questions about articulating trauma this book asks what happens when the voice of trauma is crying out from what Toni Morrison has called the most delicate most vulnerable member of society a female child and second what happens when the trauma is not just a time limit event but chronic and cumulative experiences Some traumatic experiences namely father daughter incest are culturally reduced to the untellable and yet accounts of paternal incest are readily available in American literature This book is written in part as a response to the psychological community which failed to include complex PTSD in the latest edition of the DSM DSM 5 denying victims many of whom are father daughter incest survivors the validation and recognition they deserve and leaving many misdiagnosed

ethnic female adolescents The books chosen for the purpose of this thesis portray girls in an adolescent period The adolescents presented in this study are aged between ten and twenty one and are socially economically and politically dependent on their parents or guardians To further complicate matters the experiences of girls of colour are more complex than those encountered by white adolescents As the typical conflicts within the family problems with gender sexual development education and friends are juxtaposed with issues of racism and very often a lower social status In the light of these facts it does not come as a surprise that many ethnic adolescent girls have problems finding their self The first section of the initial chapter of this thesis takes into consideration the stereotypical image of Euro American adolescent girl as it often serves as a contradiction of the popular images of ethnic girls Furthermore the chapter examines stereotypes of African American Chinese American and Mexican American adolescents Despite their variety the stereotypes are the cause of girls victimisation in society The five following chapters analyse the problems more often

The Female Bildungsroman by Toni Morrison and Maxine Hong Kingston Pin-chia Feng, 1998 This study traces the textual construction of identity in the female Bildungsroman of Toni Morrison and Maxine Hong Kingston Deploying the politics of rememory in their textual representation of female development Morrison and Kingston unearth the multiple layers of repressed memories including personal stories specific cultural history and racial experience of African and Asian American women This book analyzes the working through of repressed memories in Morrison s *The Bluest Eye* and *Sula* and Hong Kingston s *The Woman Warrior* and *China Men* The gap between Bildung and anti Bildung in these texts highlights the multiple oppression faced by women of color and interrogates the established standards and value system of the hegemonic culture

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
