The Transformation of Natural Philosophy Sachiko Kusukawa, 1995-03-09 This book proposes that Philip Melanchthon was responsible for transforming traditional university natural philosophy into a specifically Lutheran one Motivated by desire to check civil disobedience and promote a Lutheran orthodoxy he created a natural philosophy based on Aristotle Galen and Plato incorporating contemporary findings of Copernicus and Vesalius The fields of astrology anatomy botany and mathematics all constituted a natural philosophy in which Melanchthon wished to demonstrate God's Providential design in the physical world Rather than dichotomizing or synthesizing the two distinct areas of science and religion Kusukawa advocates the need to look at Natural philosophy as a discipline quite different from either modern science or religion a contextual assessment of the implication of the Lutheran Reformation on university education particularly on natural philosophy

Mathematical Practitioners and the Transformation of Natural Knowledge in Early Modern Europe Lesley B. Cormack, Steven A. Walton, John A. Schuster, 2017-03-15 This book argues that we can only understand transformations of nature studies in the Scientific Revolution if we take seriously the interaction between practitioners those who know by doing and scholars those who know by thinking These are not in opposition however Theory and practice are end points on a continuum with some participants interested only in the practical others only in the theoretical and most in the murky intellectual and material world in between It is this borderland where influence appropriation and collaboration have the potential to lead to new methods new subjects of enquiry and new social structures of natural philosophy and science The case for connection between theory and practice can be most persuasively drawn in the area of mathematics which is the focus of this book Practical mathematics was a growing field in early modern Europe and these essays are organised into three parts which contribute to the debate about the role of mathematical practice in the Scientific Revolution First they demonstrate the variability of the identity of practical mathematicians and of the practices involved in their activities in early modern Europe Second readers are invited to consider what practical mathematics looked like and that although practical mathematical knowledge was transmitted and circulated in a wide variety of ways participants were able to recognize them all as practical mathematics Third the authors show how differences and nuances in practical mathematics typically depended on the different contexts in which it was practiced social cultural political and economic particularities matter Historians of science especially those interested in the Scientific Revolution period and the history of mathematics will find this book and its ground breaking approach of particular interest

A History of Natural Philosophy Edward Grant,2007-01-22 Natural philosophy encompassed all natural phenomena of the physical world It sought to discover the physical causes of all natural effects and was little concerned with mathematics By contrast the exact mathematical sciences were narrowly confined to various computations that did not involve physical causes functioning totally independently of natural philosophy Although this began slowly to change in the late Middle Ages a much more thoroughgoing union of natural philosophy and mathematics occurred in the seventeenth century and thereby made the Scientific Revolution possible The title of Isaac Newton s great work *The Mathematical Principles of Natural Philosophy* perfectly reflects the new relationship Natural philosophy became the Great Mother of the Sciences which by the nineteenth century had nourished the manifold chemical physical and biological sciences to maturity thus enabling them to leave the Great Mother and emerge as the multiplicity of independent sciences we know today

British Philosophy in the Seventeenth Century Sarah Hutton,2015-06-04 Sarah Hutton presents a rich historical study of one of the most fertile periods in modern philosophy It was in the seventeenth century that Britain's first philosophers of international stature and lasting influence emerged Its
