The Outside Thing Hannah Roche, 2019-05-28 In a lecture delivered before the University of Oxford's Anglo-French Society in 1936, Gertrude Stein described romance as the outside thing that is always a thing to be felt inside. Hannah Roche takes Stein's definition as a principle for the reinterpretation of three major modernist lesbian writers, showing how literary and affective romance played a crucial yet overlooked role in the works of Stein, Radclyffe Hall, and Djuna Barnes. *The Outside Thing* offers original readings of both canonical and peripheral texts, including Stein's first novel *Q.E.D.
