World Politics and the Evolution of War John J. Weltman, 1995 In this comprehensive study international relations scholar John Weltman explores the many roles of war in world politics With topics ranging from the development of strategic thought to the effects on war of political and technological change from the uses of force and threats of force to the uses of arms control from the prominence of war in history to its likely fate in the post Cold War world Weltman's analysis offers a detailed thoroughgoing and rigorous overview of the subject Throughout Weltman questions a number of widely held assumptions To the conventional argument that the number of players in the international system

determines the incidence and character of war he responds with evidence that suggesting that the social material and intellectual context within which conflicts occur is far more influential. Waltman also questions the prevailing wisdom that democracies are inherently peaceful and autocracies inherently warlike, arguing instead that the propensity to wage war and the effects of war are largely the products of prevailing expectations, whether or not war offers a means for the cheap, easy, and decisive accomplishment of a government's objectives. And he criticizes the dominant view that conflict, even violent conflict, is psychologically abnormal. Drawing upon the traditional distinction between wars of attrition and wars of annihilation, Waltman sees the trend toward the former despite the anomalous Persian Gulf conflict as likely to continue. While this trend does not suggest the end of warfare, much less the end of history, it does imply the localization of conflict and the minimization of the danger of global conflagration. The new world order, Waltman concludes, will be far from peaceful, but the conflicts that do arise will be slow burning and difficult to spread. Outside intervention in these conflicts will be costly.

The Cold War ended with an exhilarating wave of events: the toppling of the Berlin Wall, the rise of the dissident poet Vaclav Havel, the revolution in Romania. Americans rejoiced at the dramatic conclusion of the long struggle. But victories in wars, hot or cold, tend to unfocus the mind, writes John Gaddis. It can be a dangerous thing to have achieved one's objectives because one then has to decide what to do next. In The United States and the End of the Cold War, Gaddis provides a sharp focus on the long history of the Cold War, shedding new light on its sudden ending as well as on what might come next. In this provocative, insightful book, Gaddis offers a number of thoughtful essays on the history of international relations during the last half century. And he takes a second look at the importance of espionage and intelligence in Cold War history, a field often left to buffs and spy novelists. Most important, he focuses on the central elements in superpower relations. In an eloquent account of the American style of foreign policy in the twentieth century, for instance, he explores how Americans, having learned the lesson of Adolf Hitler, consistently equated the forms of foreign governments with their external behavior, assuming that authoritarian states would be aggressive states. He also analyzes the tectonics of Cold War history, demonstrating how long-term changes in international affairs and Soviet bloc countries built up pressures that led to the sudden earthquakes of 1989. And along the way, Gaddis illuminates such topics as the role of morality in American foreign policy, the relevance of nuclear weapons to the balance of power, and the objectives of containment. He even includes and criticizes an essay entitled How the Cold War Might End, written before the dramatic events of recent years to demonstrate how quickly the tide of history can overwhelm contemporary analysis. Gaddis concludes with a thoughtful consideration of the problems and forces at work in the post-Cold War world.
