the one hand and Clare Boothe Luce and *Spiritual Mobilization* on the other Using Heard as a prism through which to examine popular ideas Falby shows that the twentieth century contained much political and religious heterogeneity This heterogeneity illustrates the diverse and overlapping roots of both liberal religion and conservative politics in the twenty first century
