We Rode the Orphan Trains Andrea Warren, 2001 Listen to child orphans as they share their memories of transition and adventure disappointment and loneliness but ultimately of the joy of belonging to their own new families They were throwaway kids living in the streets or in orphanages and foster homes Then Charles Loring Brace a young minister working with the poor in New York City started the Children s Aid Society and devised a plan to give homeless children a chance to find families to call their own Thus began an extraordinary migration of American children Between 1854 and 1929 an estimated 200 000 children mostly from New York and other cities of the eastern United States ventured forth to other states on a journey of hope Andrea Warren has shared the stories of some of these orphan train riders here including those of Betty who found a fairy tale life in a grand hotel Nettie Evans and her twin Nellie who were rescued from their first abusive placement and taken in by a new kindhearted family who gave them the love they had hoped for brothers Howard and Fred who remained close even though they were adopted into different families and Edith who longed to know the secrets of her past This is powerful nonfiction for classroom and personal reading and for discussion School Library Journal starred review

[From Cradle to Grave](#) Louisiana Orphan Train Society, 2014-09-01 On the mean streets of New York City in the early 1900s children were either left on the streets to fend for themselves or taken to an orphanage They were torn from families who were destitute sick or dying Leaving the streets of New York the children came to the countryside of Louisiana by trains escorted by their nuns nurses and agents The orphan train rider s stories may sound like fiction but in reality it is the story of their lives From Cradle to Grave is only a small collection of stories from the descendants who put together the bits and

pieces they received from relatives Treatment of the orphans to some was an injustice but in actuality it was a blessing They were given shelter food and medical care With the passage of time they were placed on trains and sent to other states They rode the rails for a better life Though many were faced with perils and hardships many were not They were survivors and overcame those perils and hardships For many orphans cotton corn and sweet potato fields were not only their workplace but their playgrounds as well especially in the southern part of Louisiana where farming was the way of life Many of the orphans who were brought to these farms learned farming first hand and became successful later in life even though they may not have had a formal education For too many years they were ignored and their stories were hushed They were ashamed of being orphans mostly because they were often reminded of who they were and where they came from However they bounced back they were accepted and were raised in the cultures of their communities Though most have left their earthly homes it is time to reflect on what they were able to accomplish The majority were good providers and overprotective of their children They were always looking for better things for their children than they had been provided with Their stories are proof that hard work and a positive attitude make anything possible
