I trust that you had a good summer and I would like to welcome you back to our new academic year 2013-2014. I have always been enthusiastic about the beginning of school. Even as a child the start of the school year meant new things, like new uniforms, new stationery, a new classroom, new teachers, meeting new students as well as connecting back with old friends. This is a great time to start with a new outlook. Remind your children about their accomplishments last year, and if they did not do as well last year, talk to them and discuss how they can start afresh and do things differently this year.

This year we will be introducing a new character development program at AAM called Bucket Filling. If a student is in need of additional counseling services outside of the school environment, referrals can be made. Individual counseling can begin at any time during the year and you will be informed in case your child is referred for Individual counseling.
