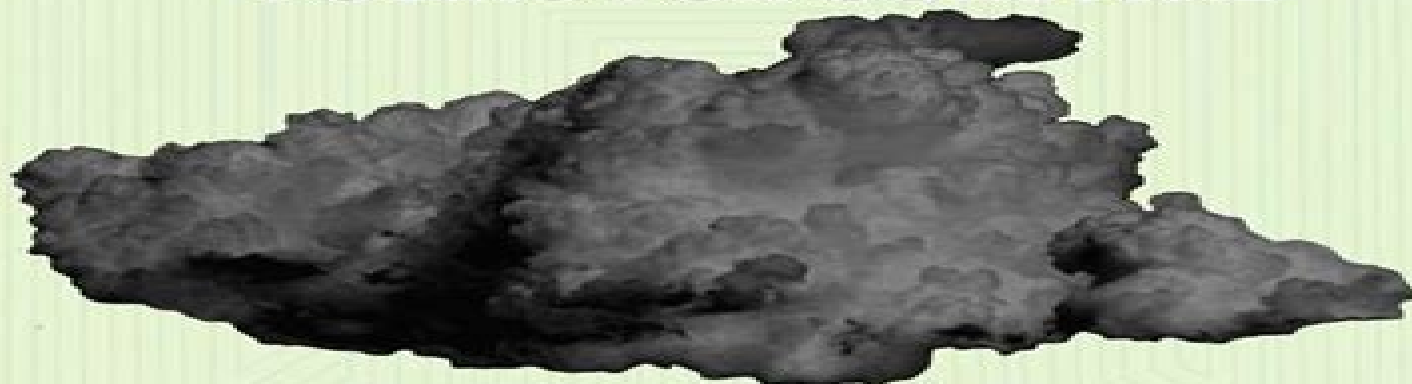

Never to Be Forgotten Beatrice Muchman,2012-03 From Booklist Muchman was born in Berlin in 1933 In March 1939 she her parents and four relatives fled to Brussels to escape the Nazi regime In 1942 Germany occupied Belgium and Muchman s parents brought her and her cousin to the home of two Catholic women for safekeeping Her parents were killed she survived and was ultimately brought to the U S where she was adopted by an aunt and uncle in Chicago Muchman grew up believing that her Jewish parents had abandoned her In 1990 a box was discovered in her uncle s home that contained faded letters documents and old photographs the letters had been written by her parents in the 1940s I finally was able to discover in a deep fundamental way that my parents had loved me more than life itself the author relates This important book brings the enormous magnitude of the Holocaust down to a very personal level It contains poignant black and white family photographs and reproductions of passports and other documents
