COUNTY HISTORICAL MARKER TO BE DEDICATED SUNDAY

Sunday, July 4th is Albany, Texas, will be a day of celebration for Shackelford County as it will be for thousands of other counties and communities across the country. As part of the festivities an historical marker telling of the county's origin will be dedicated on the courthouse lawn. Commemorative will begin with the dedication of the Bicentennial Pavilion and will take place promptly at 1:00 P.M. with the nation-wide bell ringing. The recognition following will be other patriotic programs of 1976.

Commemorative on the marker are Shackelford County's first permanent settlers, Mr. and Mrs. George Greer, Mr. and Mrs. W.H. Leffler, Mr. and Mrs. J.C. Lynch, and Mr. and Mrs. Lynn E. Jackson. Each couple came here before 1860, loving the territory of the semicircle Comanche Indian. During the Civil War two family forts, Fort Magginnville and Fort Hubbard, were an scattered settlement banded together for

protection. In 1967 Fort Griffin was established, and "The Flat" or Griffin developed as a wild and today frontier settlement. In the fall of 1974 the county formally organized and elected the officers. The organizing new sheriff, Henry Jacobs, promoted a more centrally located are in the county for the county seat. In a last decision, Albany beat Fort Griffin for this honor, and Jacobs proceeded to develop his town.

With the arrival of the Texas Central, the Morris area was born and grew into Albany by the addition of many new citizens. After 1900 the economy of Shackelford County could depend not only on farming and ranching but also on oil and gas exploration and production which remains an important asset for us today and the basis for our economic life.

Many visitors were seen enjoying the historical markers during Fandangle time. The county marker will be the 5th historical marker erected during this Bicentennial year.

NOW AND THEN RELEASED, TO BE ON SALE AT FAIR

Fandangle Accidents Injure 3

Two spectators and one cast member were injured in an explosion and two horses collided during the flag parade, resulting in the death of one horse. The fatal performance of the 1976 show.

Thomas Lincoln Kerrary of Fort Worth remains hospitalized in a Fort Worth hospital in "stable condition. Surgery was required to remove bone fragments from Kerrary's brain, but apparently no permanent damage was done. He was struck in the head by a metal fragment from a 1 1/2" steel plate that was used in a July 4 celebration during the Fandangle show.

Also injured by a huge 8 lb. piece of metal that struck him on the knee was Bill Swindle of Houston. He was treated and released at Shackelford County Hospital.

Petty Fielder, a member of the cast, was struck by pieces of wood fragments, treated and released.

Apparently the 1 1/2" steel plate used to contain the explosion of a 1/4 inch dynamite had weakened sufficiently during the previous show and released to cause a to split during the Saturday night show. The plate of steel approximately 2 feet square by 1 1/2" in thickness, was used to hold a woman A metal hole was drilled in the plate to accommodate the dynamite and placed an steel over the hole. Upon the explosion of the dynamite, the steel broke, the steel simply shot in the air, but Saturday night the metal plate split, causing the plate to

whirl across the stage into the audience. Portions of this plate struck the two men, while portions of the stump hit Mrs. Fielder.

Horses ridden by Richard Rumpas and Benton Green

collided in the opening of the flag parade, causing one horse to be put to sleep. Green's injuries sustained. The riders were not injured and the horse ridden by Green is apparently all right, but is still under observation.

GEORGIA FOUNTAIN OPENED WITH BEAUTIFUL CEREMONIES

Albany, Texas had possibly its finest hour last Thursday as it dedicated a massive rock fountain to the men of the Georgia Battalion. As Mrs. Lyndon Johnson ran the ribbon to officially start the water flowing, the pride of Albany shone its brightest.

The completion of the fountain was the crowning of a debt to Georgia incurred during Texas's fight for independence. The memorial service was an impressive display of patriotic and military expression by the persons involved in the program as well as the thousands attending.

As the Albany High Band played the "Star Spangled Banner," "Old Glory" was presented and hoisted by a Color Guard from Dyess Air Force Base. A group of young Albany Scouts presented the Texas flag as the band, under the direction of Weldon McCutchen, played "Texas, Our Texas."

Roger Richardson of North-Houston Unit, gave the invocation, which was followed by welcoming remarks from Joe Ray Jensen, mayor of Albany. Jensen expressed his thanks for this opportunity to

"do our thing." Harry Holter, "father of the project," expressed his feelings toward the men of the Georgia Battalion followed by the reading of the inscriptions by Mrs. C.E. Jacobs and Bob Green. Jim Walter and Kyle Vertel unveiled the markers as they were read.

Erig. General Otto E. Schers presented the Georgia flag to Brig. Gen. Raymond E. East of Georgia who, with his southern accent, and inspiring words, took the hearts of many Texans back to Georgia with him. He explained that the same spirit of freedom and independence that brought the Georgians to Texas will be the spirit that keeps us free today.

Gen. Green then presented the flag to another Dyess Color Guard, consisting of Georgia Scouts to be placed in the Texas sky with pride, alongside that of the Lone Star State.

Lady Bird Johnson was then escorted to the fountain to clip the ribbon and signal the rise of the water from the rock.

As the large crowd sang "America, the Beautiful," the program ended a beautiful day that our country should be proud to state, and for our nation.
