Nursing Care of Children and Young People with Chronic Illness Fay Valentine, Lesley Lowes, 2008-04-15 Children and young people suffering from long term conditions require continuing support and nursing care throughout their lives Nursing Care of Children and Young People with Chronic Illness explores chronic disease management in the context of recent developments including the National Service Framework for Children It addresses the aetiology of chronic illness and the impact on the child's family It also explores holistic approaches to caring for their social physical and psychological needs and highlights the importance of the nurse's role in promoting children and their parents as expert patients Nursing Care of Children and Young People with Chronic Illness is a comprehensive up to date resource for nursing students and practitioners on the context theory and practice of assessing health needs and the delivery of holistic care and services within a variety of care settings to enable them to meet the changing needs of children and young people with chronic illnesses and diseases and their families The first nursing specific text related to the care of children young people with chronic illness Incorporates case studies scenarios throughout to enable readers to gain an understanding of the application of concepts theories in practice Covers care aspects of the child and young person in different settings including tertiary secondary primary health care and the home Written in the context of the NSF for Children *Mothers, Young People and Chronic Illness* Clare Williams, 2018-10-24 This title was first published in 2003 Although young people are generally very healthy it has become clear that many of the health behaviours of young people can have serious consequences later in life This is particularly so with the management of chronic illness where poor management can result in serious long term complications This book explores how gender differentially affects both the ways in which young people manage chronic illness and the ways in which mothers care for their teenage sons and daughters Until recently where gender and health have been linked the focus has typically been on women rather than men However there is growing interest in the health of men with the recognition that masculinities and health interact in specific sometimes detrimental ways Most books examine either women's or less commonly men's health but the comparative approach proposed reflects a growing academic and empirical trend which aims to develop new theoretical perspectives both on gender and on the relationship between gender and health The book also challenges assumptions that gender is static by exploring the effects of gender at a specific time of transition in the life course The focus on adolescence is important as it is seen by many to be the time when heterosexual values are most powerfully pursued and enforced thus enabling interactions between gender and health to be thrown into relief The approach adopted takes issue with many current ideas about young people which tend to portray them as autonomous individuals acting independently For example in terms of health care for young people with a chronic illness health professionals generally adopt an individualistic approach stressing the importance of independence for young people Rather than seeing young people as purely autonomous this book relocates them within families in transition between

childhood and adulthood and acting interdependently with other family members Little is known about the complex deci

Hilberink, 2021-01-28 This book focuses on young people 12-25 years old growing up with a chronic somatic condition and/or physical disability facing different challenges during their transition to adulthood and to adult healthcare services Becoming an adult often proves extra challenging for them because the adaptive tasks related to living with a chronic condition can clash with developmental milestones Finding a good balance and integrating these tasks in daily life is also referred to as self management This book addresses self management and empowerment of young people with chronic conditions as well as the Positive Youth Development concept It elaborates on theories and approaches and offers a complete overview of self management interventions for young people with chronic conditions emphasizing on the tasks of medical emotion and role management It also elaborates on the roles and tasks of professionals as well as the patient provider relationship the shifting roles between young people and their parents and the role of peer support This book is unique in its broad view on self management i.e. it goes beyond medical management and focuses on young people achieving their maximum potential and a good quality of life Furthermore the book employs a positive youth development approach focusing on empowerment and growth rather than problems or issues It offers an overview of the state of the art and evidence concerning self management support for young people with various chronic conditions As such it is of benefit for all healthcare professionals working in care for young people but also for researchers interested in this topic
