Young Citizen Old Soldier". From boyhood in Antrim to Hell on the Somme David Truesdale, 2012-08-19 For almost 43 years three school notebooks lay in obscurity in the County Armagh home of sixty two year old James McRoberts The closely filled pages recorded just over two years in his life in uniform as he played his part in what was then known as the Great War During the Home Rule crisis of 1914 one of several in Ireland's history James McRoberts like many other men joined the Young Citizen Volunteers an organization that eventually became the 14th Royal Irish Rifles a battalion of the 36th Ulster Division These notebooks written at the time and with footnotes added some forty years later record his Army service between 8 January 1915 and 3 April 1917 They tell with remarkable immediacy of his time at Randalstown County Antrim and the move to Seaford in East Sussex From here after further training James moved with his Battalion to the trenches of the Western Front Written with a degree of humor and some detail his story covers the mundane routine of camp life recreation behind the lines the horrors of enemy shelling the deaths of good friends and the momentous events of 1 July 1916 on the Somme when his unit was in the thick of the action On 1 November 1917 while acting as a scout for a night patrol at Messines Ridge James was seriously wounded and evacuated to hospital for him the War was over Nevertheless he continued to record what was happening around him both with humour and in detail Classed as 80% disabled he was eventually discharged and returned home to enjoy a postwar career as a surveyor in County Armagh This is a remarkable memoir that is by turns lively candid humorous poignant and

Catastrophe, 1941 Lev Lopukhovsky, Stuart Britton, 2013-08-01 This book describes one of the most terrible tragedies of the Second World War and the events preceding it The horrible miscalculations made by the Stavka of the Soviet Supreme High Command and the Front commands led in October 1941 to the deaths and imprisonment of hundreds of thousands of their own people Until recently the magnitude of the defeats suffered by the Red Army at Viaz ma and Briansk were simply kept hushed up For the first time in this book a full picture of the combat operations that led to this tragedy are laid out in detail using previously unknown or little used documents The author was driven to write this book after his long years of fruitless search to learn what happened to his father Colonel N I Lopukhovsky the commander of the 120th Howitzer Artillery Regiment who disappeared together with his unit in the maelstrom of Operation Typhoon He became determined to break the official silence surrounding the military disaster on the approaches to Moscow in the autumn of 1941 In the present edition the author additionally introduces documents from German military archives which will doubtlessly interest not only scholars but also students of the Eastern Front of the Second World War Lopukhovsky substantiates his position on the matter of the true extent of the losses of the Red Army in men and equipment which greatly exceeded the official data In the Epilogue he briefly discusses the searches he has conducted with the aim of revealing the circumstances surrounding the deaths of Soviet soldiers who to this point have been listed among the missing in action including his own father The narrative is enhanced by numerous photographs color maps and tables Lev Nikolaevich Lopukhovsky graduated from the prestigious Frunze Military Academy in 1962 and spent the next ten years serving in the Soviet Union s Strategic Rocket forces rising to the rank of colonel and a regiment commander before transferring to a teaching position in the Frunze

Barbarossa Derailed: The Battle for Smolensk 10 July-10 September 1941 David Glantz, 2012-04-10 The second half of a two part study on Operation Barbarossa Hitler's plan to invade Soviet Russia during World War II and what went wrong At dawn on 10 July 1941 massed tanks and motorized infantry of German Army Group Center's Second and Third Panzer Groups crossed the Dnepr and Western Dvina Rivers beginning what Hitler and most German officers and soldiers believed would be a triumphal march on Moscow the Soviet capital Less than three weeks before on 22 June Hitler had unleashed his Wehrmacht's massive invasion of the Soviet Union code named Operation Barbarossa which sought to defeat the Soviet Red Army conquer the country and unseat its Communist ruler Josef Stalin Between 22 June and 10 July the Wehrmacht advanced up to 500 kilometers into Soviet territory killed or captured up to one million Red Army soldiers and reached the western banks of the Western Dvina and Dnepr Rivers by doing so satisfying the premier assumption of Plan Barbarossa that the Third Reich would emerge victorious if it could defeat and destroy the bulk of the Red Army before it withdrew to safely behind those two rivers With the Red Army now shattered Hitler and most Germans expected total victory in a matter of weeks The ensuing battles in the Smolensk region frustrated German hopes for quick victory Once across the Dvina and Dnepr Rivers a surprised Wehrmacht encountered five fresh Soviet armies Quick victory eluded the Germans Instead Soviet forces encircled in Mogilev and Smolensk stubbornly refused to surrender and while they fought on during July August and into early September first five and then a total of seven newly mobilized Soviet armies struck back viciously at the advancing Germans conducting multiple counterattacks and counterstrokes capped by two major counteroffensives that sapped German strength and will Despite immense losses in men and materiel these desperate Soviet actions derailed Operation Barbarossa Smarting from countless wounds inflicted on his vaunted Wehrmacht even before the fighting ended in the Smolensk region Hitler postponed his march on Moscow and instead turned his forces southward to engage softer targets in the Kiev region The derailment of the Wehrmacht at Smolensk ultimately became the crucial turning point in Operation Barbarossa This groundbreaking study now significantly expanded exploits a wealth of Soviet and German archival materials including the combat orders and

The Role of the Soviet Union in the Second World War Boris Sokolov, 2013-04-24 This book investigates several controversial issues regarding the role of the Soviet Union and the performance of the Soviet government and Red Army to which the author provides some provocative answers The primary question explored by the author however regards the effectiveness of both the Red Army and of the Soviet military economy Dr Sokolov argues that the chief defect of the Soviet military economy was the disproportionate emphasis on the production of tanks and aircraft at the expense of transportation means and the means of command and control This leads the author to look at the role of Lend

Within this context the Duchies of Schleswig and Holstein were caught between the rising nationalism and desire for unification of the Prussian German nation states and the traditional alliances with the Danish Kingdom The Schleswig Holsteiners decided that allegiance with the German Federation including possessing their own constitution was the best way forward They rebelled against the Danish and looked to the Prussians with their greater military prowess for help In Denmark as in other European countries the call for a democratic constitution caused social disturbance triggered initially by the February riots in Paris The Danish monarchy in crisis both constitutionally and in terms of monarchical succession continued to lay claim on their southernmost duchies and sent their armed forces to destroy the Schleswig Holstein insurgents The author describes the battles and battlefields upon which this crisis was played out from the first major action at Bov 9 April 1848 to the last major battles of the war at Isted 25 July 1850 and Missunde 12 September 1850 from the geomorphic landscape influencing battlefield strategy down to the description of a farmhouse where Prussian officers jumped out of windows to save themselves from the Danish

Muddling Through Peter Howson, 2014-01-19 As with many other aspects of the British army the outbreak of World War One started a process of change that was to result in a radically different provision of chaplaincy care once the war was over Nothing was ever simple with army chaplaincy The war saw an increase in the number of churches becoming involved with the army The structure had already been under pressure in the first decade of the century with the Catholic Church insisting on new rules for its chaplains The creation of the Territorial Force added a new dimension after 1907 bringing new players into the mix including the Jewish community These chaplains challenged the traditional Garrison Church based ministry of the regulars The book examines the muddled state of chaplaincy in August 1914 and looks at how chaplains were mobilized It then reviews how organizational changes were often the result of pressure from the different churches The unilateral decision of the Church of England in July 1915 to leave the unified administration in France that had existed since August 1914 is examined in the light of the availability of the relevant volume of the diaries of Bishop Gwynne a key participant in the change Chapters also look at the experience of other Imperial forces and of the casualties suffered by chaplains These all provide evidence of the expectations that various groups had of army chaplains It is often forgotten that two chaplains were captured during the retreat from Mons in 1914 They were never far from the fighting throughout the war The experiences of the war meant that the pre war structure needed reform The final chapter looks at the structure that was created in 1920 and then survived virtually unchanged until 2004 Army chaplaincy has always been a mix of Church Army and State Such a coming together inevitably lead to confusion Not surprisingly one of the themes was the muddle that resulted Even so army chaplaincy ended the war with a much higher profile than the one it had in 1914 This was recognised by the addition of Royal creating the RACHD Anglicans Catholics Presbyterians Methodists and other faith groups as well as military historians will find this book of interest as it overturns a number of myths and puts chaplaincy in its wider context

Mrs Adolf Hitler Blaine Taylor, 2013-06-19 The year 2012 marks

the centenary of Eva Braun's birth This is the strange but true saga of her life richly illustrated from her own personal photograph albums as well as from other captured German archives She married German dictator Adolf Hitler but 36 hours before their joint suicides in Berlin on April 30 1945 in the last week of the Second World War in Europe This exciting pictorial biography tells the full story of a Catholic convent bred young woman not only as the secret mistress as many historians have painted her since her voluntary death at age 33 but also as Hitler's lawfully wedded wife even though she is still largely referred to today by her maiden name They met at a Munich photography shop in 1929 when she was but 17 and he was already 40 The true nature of their long relationship is fully explained in detail for the very first time she was heterosexual and he bisexual but the author concludes Eva most likely remained a virgin until the day she died Although many reports after the war claimed that he shot himself and that she took poison the official Russian autopsy of their partially burnt bodies asserted that both died by cyanide capsules despite the postwar testimony of all Hitler's closest aides lending even their deaths an air of mystery Who was she really The answers are here This fascinating gripping and tragic story of a pretty well liked middle class shop girl is of a life mainly lived in the iron shadow of history In death Eva Braun Hitler became and remains today a hundred years after her birth one of the most famous women in all of world history alongside such female luminaries as Joan of Arc Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis and Princess Diana Eva has been a figure shrouded in controversy misinformation myth and legend until now At long last the veil is lifted with over 300 photographs providing an extensive collection of imagery including a number of contemporary color shots Eva Braun had a lifelong passion for photography her close friends nicknamed her the Rolleiflex girl after a camera model and this is reflected in the array of imagery featured in this groundbreaking book

Mau Mau Peter Baxter, 2012-12-19 An informative and readable account of the growth of the politically motivated and extremely violent Mau Mau in Kenya Military Historical Society The Second World War forever altered the complexion of the British Empire From Cyprus to Malaya from Borneo to Suez the dominoes began to fall within a decade of peace in Europe Africa in the late 1940s and 1950s was energized by the grant of independence to India and the emergence of a credible indigenous intellectual and political caste that was poised to inherit control from the waning European imperial powers In Kenya however matters were different A vociferous local settler lobby had accrued significant economic and political authority under a local legislature coupled with the fact that much familial pressure could be brought to bear in Whitehall by British settlers of wealth and influence most of whom were utterly irreconciled to the notion of any kind of political hand over Mau Mau was less than a liberation movement but much more than a mere civil disturbance This book covers the emergence and growth of Mau Mau and the strategies applied by the British to confront and nullify what was in reality a tactically inexperienced but nonetheless powerfully symbolic black expression of political violence That Mau Mau set the tone for Kenyan independence somewhat blurred the clean line of victory and defeat The revolt was suppressed and peace restored but events in the colony were nevertheless swept along by the greater

movement of Africa toward independences resulting in the eventual establishment of majority rule in Kenya in 1964

Portuguese Dragoons 1966-1974 John P. Cann, 2019-12-12 Between 1961 and 1974 Portugal fought a war to retain its African colonies of Angola Guinea Bissau and Mozambique Collectively known as the Campaigns for Africa the origin of the conflict stems from the post World War II atmosphere of nationalism and anti colonial fervor The Angolan insurgency began in 1961 followed by unrest in Guinea Bissau in 1963 and Mozambique in 1964 Portugal s initial actions in Angola were based on foot slogging by infantry considered the best method of addressing an insurgency not only to hunt the enemy but also to keep contact with the population But in the vast areas of Angola the majority of which was unsuited to wheeled vehicles this tactical approach was too painful and for Portugal the number of troops available was limited The helicopter was a possible solution but it was beyond Portugal s finance resources and it had a tendency to fly over those areas where it was vital to communicate with the population and secure its loyalty When in 1966 the enemy guerrillas sought a new front in eastern Angola Portugal needed a force that could combine mobility over rough terrain with the ability to engage insurgents while maintaining strong links with the population One of the adaptive solutions to this challenge was found in the past create horse cavalry units in the form of dragoons that were equally trained for cavalry or infantry service just as their historical predecessors fought In this particular case adaptive tactics involved adjusting existing military methods and means from the traditional and available inventory to craft a solution that would deny eastern Angola to insurgents and support the population there This story is about imaginative thinking that instead of a forced abandonment of the old led to a resurrection of the old

With the Red Devils at Arnhem Marek Swiecicki, 2013-07-19 The Battle of Arnhem remains a much studied and discussed battle with an uninterrupted flow of books being published about it Helion are bringing back into print a fascinating eyewitness account that has remained overlooked since it was last published shortly after the battle itself The 1st Polish Parachute Brigade played both an important and controversial role at Arnhem The author

a Pole himself was attached to the Brigade saw action at Arnhem and managed to escape capture and return to Allied lines. He penned his account within weeks of returning and as a result *With the Red Devils at Arnhem* has a tremendous freshness and appeal sometimes lacking in material written years afterwards. He offers a vivid insight into the experiences of the Poles at Arnhem written in an exciting and lively manner. The Helion reprint has been expanded by airborne forces expert and author Niall Cherry's additional notes providing further information and context. This book is a forgotten gem within the canon of Arnhem literature.

War of Intervention in Angola Adrien Fontanellaz, José Matos, Tom Cooper, 2020-11-23. *War of Intervention in Angola Volume 3* covers the air warfare during the II Angolan War fought 1975-1992 through narrating the emergence and operational history of the Angolan Air Force and Air Defence Force FAPA DAA as told by Angolan and Cuban sources. Most accounts of this conflict better known in the West as the Border War or the Bush War as named by its South African participants tend to find the operations by the FAPA DAA barely worth mentioning. A handful of published histories mention two of its MiG 21s claimed as shot down by Dassault Mirage F 1 interceptors of the South African Air Force SAAF in 1981 and 1982 and at least something about the activities of its MiG 23 interceptors during the battles of the 1987-1988 period. On the contrary the story told by Angolan and Cuban sources not only reveals an entirely different image of the air war over Angola of the 1980s indeed it reveals to what degree this conflict was dictated by the availability or the lack of air power and shows that precisely this issue dictated the way that the commanders of the Cuban contingents deployed to the country whether as advisors or as combat troops planned and conducted their operations. It is thus little surprising that the first contingent of Cuban troops deployed to Angola during Operation Carlota in late 1975 included a sizeable group of pilots and ground personnel who subsequently helped build up the FAPA DAA from virtually nothing. They continued that work over the following 14 years sometimes in cooperation of Soviet advisors and others from East European countries eventually establishing an air force that by 1988 maintained what South African military intelligence and the media subsequently described as the most advanced air defense system in Africa. Not only the air defense system in question but also the aircraft serving as its extended arms ultimately managed a unique feat in contemporary military history they enabled an air force equipped with Soviet made aircraft and trained along the Soviet doctrine to establish at least a semblance of aerial superiority over an air force equipped with Western made aircraft and operating under a Western doctrine. Based on extensive research with help of Angolan and Cuban sources the *War of Intervention in Angola Volume 3* traces the military build up of the FAPA DAA in the period 1975-1992 its capabilities and its intentions. Moreover it provides a unique blow by blow account of its combat operations and experiences. The volume is illustrated with 100 rare photographs half a dozen maps and 15 color profiles thus providing a unique source of reference on this topic.

Ice Steel and Fire Linda Parker, 2013-07-19. The generation that reached maturity in the inter war years had grown up in the shadow of the heroic age of Polar exploration and the sacrifices of a generation in the Great War. Their own adventures were to prove as astonishing

and heroic as those of a previous generation The members of the British Arctic air route expedition to Greenland including Martin Lindsay Quintin Riley and Freddie Spencer Chapman were to pioneer the weather research methods necessary for Trans Atlantic Flight The university expeditions to Spitsbergen led by George Binney in the 1920s and Sandy Glen in the 1930s traversed and surveyed unexplored ground and contributed to developments in polar flight and radar Glen s expeditions added to the knowledge of Arctic conditions by over wintering Other pre war exploits of these adventurers included a voyage around the world the wrong way and participation in the British Graham Land Antarctic expedition Peter Fleming brother to the creator of James Bond Ian Fleming spent the 1930s exploring Brazil China and Tartary Fleming s exploits are recounted in detail in this book The character skills and endurance obtained in these years set these adventurers and explorers apart as men who were to play a distinguished and heroic role in the Second World War Their expertise in Arctic conditions small boat handling and exploring in all climatic conditions resulted in their participation in all aspects of warfare and arenas of battle particularly as exponents of special operations and as key members of Britain s first special forces Their war service took them from the fjords of Norway and Spitsbergen to the jungles of Burma and Malaya and the beaches of Normandy and Italy They were involved in blockade running covert operations in Yugoslavia Corsica and France and took part in major initiatives such as Ian Fleming s Intelligence gathering force No 30 Assault unit and the raid on St Nazaire Most of these men had known each other before war came in 1939 In some cases they ended up serving alongside one another in wartime The intertwined stories of these characters in peace and war are examples of how the spirit of adventure shown by men in the inter war years contributed to Britain s outstanding role in the Second World War Linda Parker has written an important study that is equally relevant to both the history of British exploration and the genesis and early days of Britain s special forces 1939 45 a quite unique and hitherto unexamined relationship Linda Parker combines teaching History on a part time basis with her writing and is currently completing a PhD at Birmingham University Her main areas of interest are 20th Century Military History Church History and the History of Polar exploration She is a member of the Western Front Association She was born and educated in Wales but now lives in Oxfordshire with her husband and their dog She enjoys walking and travelling ideally together and her ambition is to visit Antarctica Her first book published by Helion was The Whole Armour of God Anglican Army Chaplains in the Great War 2009

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
