The word Torah comes from an old Hebrew word that means 'to teach'. Jewish people believe that the Torah teaches them about how G-d wants them to live.

The Torah is the most holy Jewish book and contains the five books of Moses. These five books are also found in the Christian Bible: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy.

Jewish people believe that G-d dictated the Torah to Moses, who wrote down how G-d instructed the people to live. This included many rules for living and the most famous rules known as the Ten Commandments.

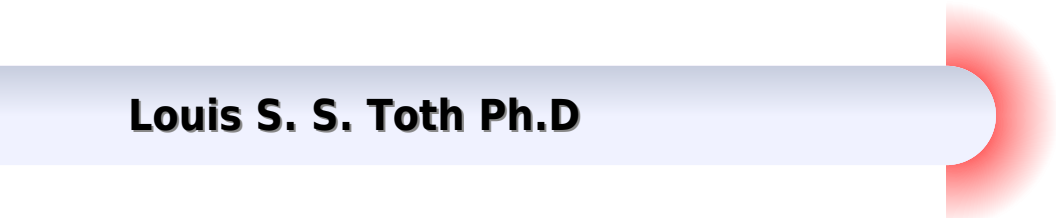
Every synagogue has a Sefer Torah in it, which is written out in Hebrew by a specially trained scribe onto a scroll. It is read aloud in the synagogue every week. The Sefer Torah is treated with great respect and is not allowed to be touched. Instead, a special stick called a gad is used to point to the words. Once the service is finished, the Torah is stored in a special place called the Ark of the Covenant so that it is protected and no one touches it.
