Standing in his way was twenty-one-year-old Dave Herron, a Pittsburgh native and former Oakmont caddie. Despite his relatively unknown status and to the shock of many, Dave beat Bobby with the most spectacular golf under par at Oakmont in U.S. Amateur history. *Upset at Oakmont* is a dual biography of two gifted child athletes in early twentieth-century America.
