The Crucified Book Anne Starr Kreps, 2022-03-29 In the Gospel of Truth a second century text associated with the Christian Platonist Valentinus a crucified Jesus is depicted as wrapped in a scroll and reading aloud the contents of his heart as he dies This is just one of many strange appearances of the physical book in this text and in the surviving fragments of Valentinus Through its

representations of the written word Anne Kreps argues the Gospel of Truth promoted a living document perspective on the holy book encouraging the generation of religious books as new sources of revelatory authority The Crucified Book locates the Gospel of Truth in a broader ancient debate about books and their attendant authority Roman and Jewish texts exhibit similar efforts to equate holy persons with holy texts while Christian heresiologists exhibit awareness of the phenomenon even as they condemn it Although the Gospel of Truth is often set apart from mainstream Christianity in scholarship its ideas about the nature of authoritative writing engaged with Greco Roman culture and cohered with Jewish and Christian ideas about books in antiquity Valentinus views about the relationship between the oral and the written dovetailed with thinking on the nature of the sacred book that gradually became the trademark of Rabbinic Judaism Kreps contends Ultimately because the Gospel of Truth reflects a mind that was at the center of the discursive debates that formed Judaism and Christianity her book demonstrates the usefulness of so called heretical texts for discussions on the parting of the ways between the two traditions

Remembering Paul Benjamin L. David Litwa, 2022-02-24 M David Litwa tells the stories of the early Christians whose religious identity was either challenged or outright denied In the second century many different groups and sects claimed to be the only Orthodox or authentic version of Christianity and Litwa shows how those groups and figures on the side of developing Christian Orthodoxy often dismissed other versions of Christianity by refusing to call them Christian However the writings and treatises against these groups contain fascinating hints of what they believed and why they called themselves Christian Litwa outlines these different groups and the controversies that surrounded them presenting readers with an overview of the vast tapestry of beliefs that made up second century Christianity By moving beyond notions of gnostic heretical and orthodox Litwa allows these lost Christianities to speak for themselves He also questions the notion of some Christian identities surviving or perishing arguing that all second century Catholic groups look very different to any form of modern Roman Catholicism Litwa shows that countless discourses ideas and practices are continually recycled and adapted throughout time in the building of Christian identities and indeed that the influence of so called lost Christianities can still be felt today

Sacred Marriages Martti Nissinen, Risto Uro, 2008-06-30 The title of this volume Sacred Marriages consciously plays with the traditional concept of sacred marriage but the plural form sacred marriages gives the reader an idea that something more is at stake here than a monomaniacal idea of manifestations deriving from a single prototype Following the guidelines of one of the contributors Ruben

Zimmermann the editors tentatively define sacred marriage as a real or symbolic union of two complementary entities imagined as gendered in a religious context Sacred marriages plural then refers to various expressions of this kind of union in different cultures that seek to overcome to cite Zimmermann again the great dualism of human and cosmic existence The subtitle indicates that the contributors are primarily interested in different aspects of the divine human sexual metaphor that is the imagining and reenactment of a gendered relationship between the human and divine worlds This metaphor which is essentially about relationship rather than sexual acts can find textual ritual mythical and social expressions in different times and places Indeed the sacred marriage ritual itself should be considered not a manifestation of the sacralized power of sexuality experienced in sexual intercourse but one way of objectifying the divine human sexual metaphor **Jerome's Commentaries on the Pauline Epistles and the Architecture of Exegetical Authority** Andrew Cain, 2021-10-07 In the late fourth and early fifth centuries during a fifty year stretch sometimes dubbed a Pauline renaissance of the western church six different authors produced over four dozen commentaries in Latin on Paul's epistles Among them was Jerome who commented on four epistles Galatians Ephesians Titus Philemon in 386 after recently having relocated to Bethlehem from Rome His commentaries occupy a time honored place in the centuries long tradition of Latin language commenting on Paul's writings They also constitute his first foray into the systematic exposition of whole biblical books and his only experiment with Pauline interpretation on this scale and so they provide precious insight into his intellectual development at a critical stage of his early career before he would go on to become the most prolific biblical scholar of Late Antiquity This monograph provides the first book length treatment of Jerome's opus Paulinum in any language Adopting a cross disciplinary approach Cain comprehensively analyzes the commentaries most salient aspects from the inner workings of Jerome's philological method and engagement with his Greek exegetical sources to his recruitment of Paul as an anachronistic surrogate for his own theological and ascetic special interests One of the overarching concerns of this book is to explore and to answer from multiple vantage points a question that was absolutely fundamental to Jerome in his fourth century context what are the sophisticated mechanisms by which he legitimized himself as a Pauline commentator not only on his own terms but also vis vis contemporary western commentators

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
