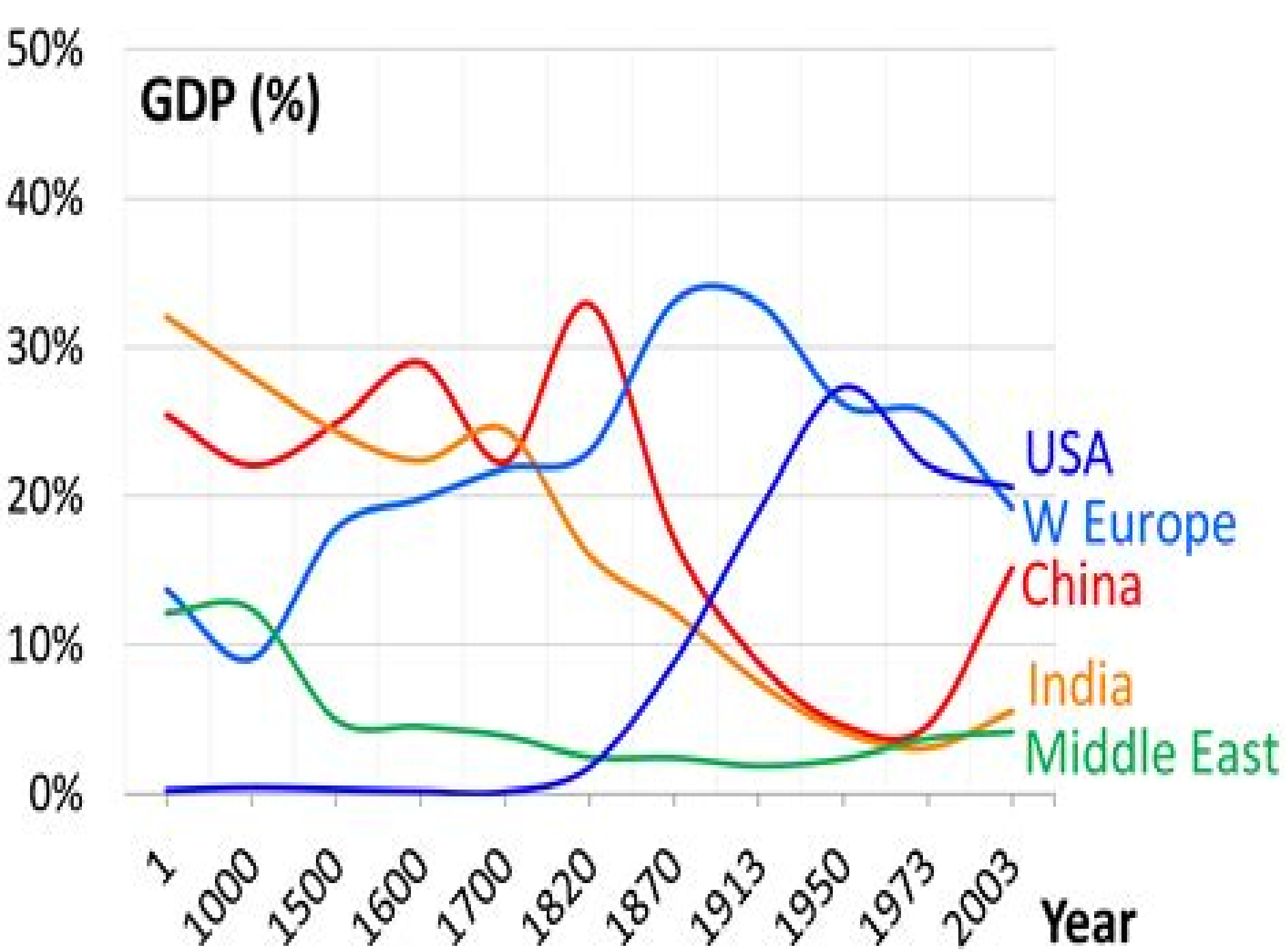

The central question of this book is whether and how such state formation did in fact contribute to economic development. Twenty chapters written by leading experts in their respective fields deal with various aspects of the book's main question. Together they identify three channels by which national unification contributed to Germany's economic development: 1. Creation of a nation state completed a process of institutional unification of a large inland area and thereby increased the integration of domestic markets. 2. Unification raised the capacity of the political system with respect to regulating complex domains such as stock companies, patenting and social insurance. 3. The emerging political regime of market preserving federalism promoted the quality of economic institutions.
