Although he belonged to an American generation of writers deeply influenced by the high modernist revolt against nature and against the self-imposed limits of realism to a palpable world William Faulkner reveals throughout his work an abiding sensitivity to the natural world He writes of the big woods of animals and of the human body as a ground of being that art and culture can neither transcend nor completely control The eleven essays that make up this volume including a paper written by the acclaimed novelist William Kennedy explore the place of the unbuilt world in Faulkner's fiction They give particular attention to the social mythic and economic significance of nature to the complexity of racial identity and to the
